

## From the Pastor

The Spring of the Church year

Where did the church get the idea of Lent? The word "Lent" in English is derived from the Germanic word for spring. What happens during the spring? The snow melts, the dirt and grime on the roads get washed away by the rains, the grass slowly begins to come alive and glows a vibrant green. The sun is visible most of the day, trees start to bud and leaves begin to form, and the early flowers begin to bud and bloom.

Lent is meant to be the springtime of the church year. So often we've seen Lent portrayed as a desert, as a place where there is no life, where nothing grows, where we cannot be nourished. In a certain sense, the desert image is correct as we journey with Jesus into the desert - but being in the desert doesn't mean that there can't be growth.

As we enter our Lenten observance, our Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving are meant to make space in our hearts for new growth, for new spiritual life. I pray that your Lent begins well and that your practices of prayer, of fasting, and of almsgiving bring about new life for you personally, for your relationships with others, and in your relationship with God.
