Know Your Faith

Precepts of the Catholic Church

The precepts of the Church are positive laws established by the Church to guide the faithful in fulfilling the minimum requirements of prayer, moral effort, and growth in love for God and neighbor. These precepts ensure that Catholics are actively participating in the life of the Church and growing closer to God. These are the precepts of the Catholic Church, listed in different ways in Sacred Scripture and the Catechism:

1. To attend Mass and to refrain from unnecessary work on Sundays and holy days.
2. To fast and abstain on appointed days.
3. To go to confession at least once a year.
4. To receive the Holy Eucharist at least once a year.
5. To contribute material support to the Church.

These precepts are intended to bind the faithful close to the Church and to God.

The precepts of the Church are not opposed to, nor are they outside of the Commandments of God. They are within the Commandments.

Jubilee Year

What is a Jubilee Year?

A Jubilee Year is a special and sacred time in the Catholic Church - celebrated every 25 years - for deep spiritual renewal, mercy, and pilgrimage. Rooted in Leviticus 25, it echoes God's call to release, reset and return. First declared in 1300, Jubilees offer powerful graces and indulgences. Jubilee 2025, proclaimed by Pope Francis, invites us to become "Pilgrims of Hope" to rediscover faith, heal as a church and walk forward in Joy. There are three ways we are marking Jubilee in our Cluster:

1. Be Formed in Hope - Sign up for the book study "Jesus and the Jubilee."
2. Serve in Hope - Have high schoolers sign up for a youth trip to Dubuque on Tuesday, July 29 - Saturday, August 2.
3. Journey in Hope - Sign up for the Parish Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse, WI on Saturday, August 2.

¿Qué es un año del Jubileo?

Un año del Jubileo es un tiempo especial y sagrado en la Iglesia Católica, que se celebra cada 25 años, para una profunda renovación espiritual, misericordia y peregrinación. Enraizado en Levítico 25, hace eco del llamado de Dios a liberar, reiniciar y regresar. Declarados por primera vez en 1300, los Jubileos ofrecen poderosas gracias e indulgencias. El Jubileo 2025, proclamado por el Papa Francisco, nos invita a convertirnos en "Peregrinos de Esperanza" para redescubrir la fe, sanar como Iglesia y caminar hacia adelante con alegría. Hay tres maneras en las que estamos celebrando el Jubileo en nuestra parroquia:

1. Asistir a Misa y abstenerse de realizar trabajos innecesarios los domingos y días festivos.
2. Ayunar y abstenerse en los días señalados.
3. Confesarse al menos una vez al año.
4. Recibir la Sagrada Eucaristía al menos una vez al año.
5. Contribuir con el apoyo material a la Iglesia.

Estos preceptos están destinados a vincular a los fieles cerca de la Iglesia y de Dios.

Los preceptos de la Iglesia no se oponen a los mandamientos de Dios ni están fuera de ellos. Están dentro de los Mandamientos.
