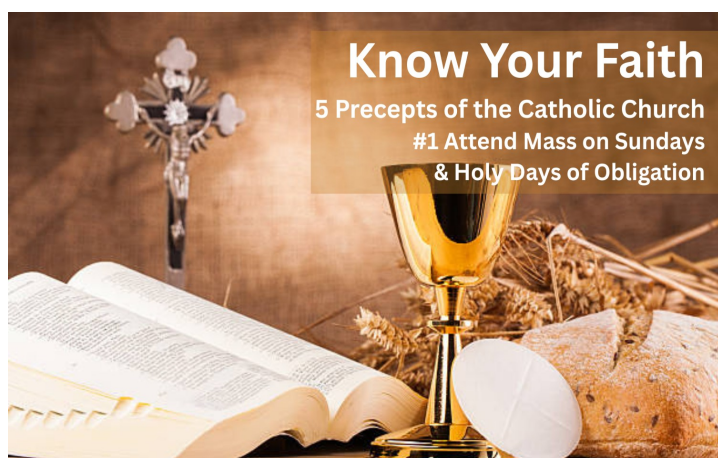

As Catholics, we are obligated to attend Mass on Sundays because Sunday is considered the Lord's Day and the day of Jesus' resurrection. It's a time for communal worship, uniting with and receiving our Lord in the Eucharist and listening to the Lord in sacred scripture. This practice connects Catholics to the History of the church and the teachings of Jesus Christ.

Here's a more detailed look at reasons we attend Mass each weekend:

- **The Resurrection of Jesus:** Sunday commemorates the resurrection of Jesus, the central event of our Christian faith.
- **Communal Worship:** Mass on Sunday is a gathering of our Christian community to worship God together.
- **Fulfilling an Obligation:** The Catholic Church views Sunday Mass as a moral obligation, a way of honoring God and receiving His grace.
- **Spiritual Nourishment:** Mass provides spiritual nourishment through the Eucharist, Scripture readings and the homily. The Eucharist is the 'source and summit' of our Christian life.
- **Witness to Faith:** Attending Mass is a way of publicly affirming one's faith and belonging to the Church.
- **Renewal and Hope:** Sunday Mass offers a reminder of God's love and the promise of resurrection, providing hope and encouragement for the week ahead.

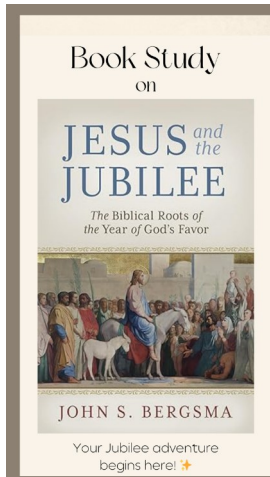
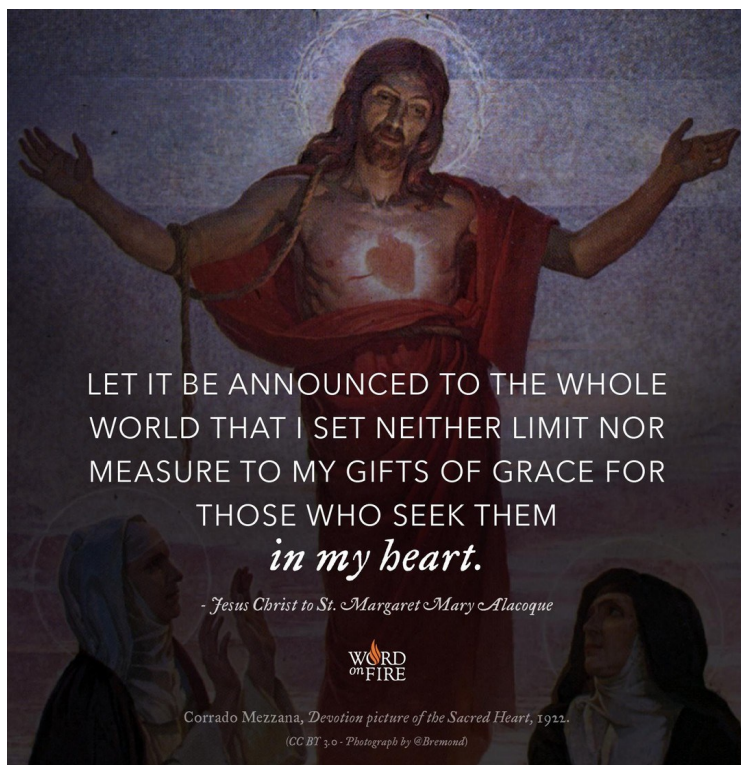
St. Patrick Date Night will be on Sunday, June 22 at 5:30pm in the cafeteria. Please RSVP for daycare at [641] 484-3646.

Grupo de Estudio Bíblico

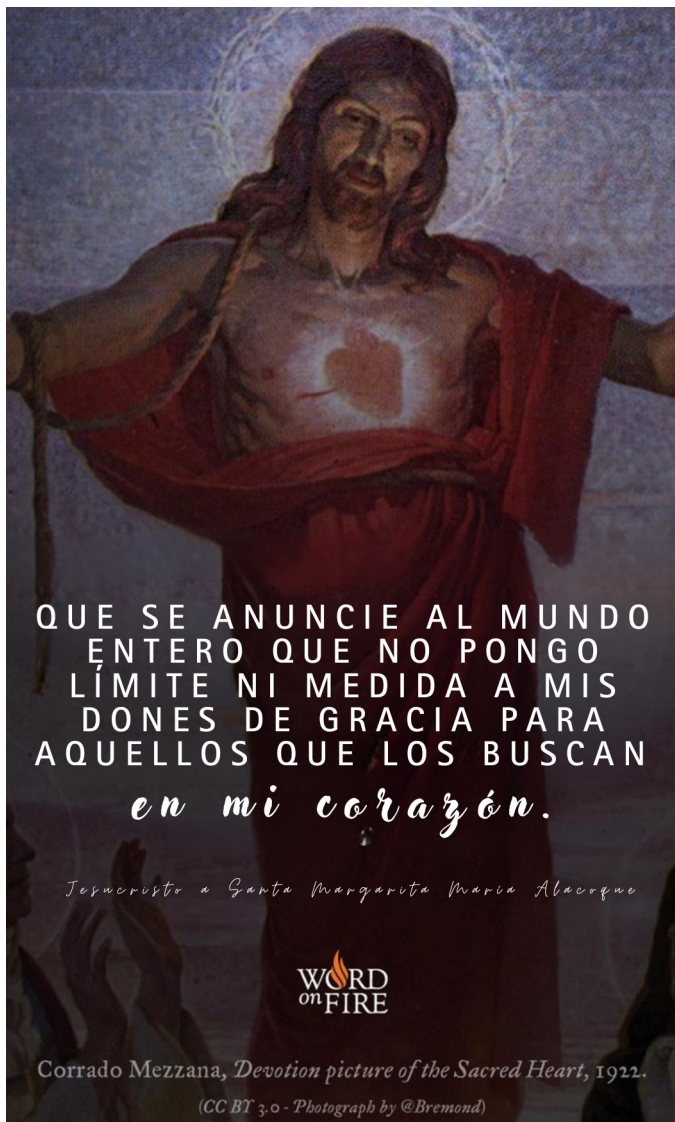
Grupo de mujeres - El grupo de mujeres se reúnen los viernes a las 5 PM en el segundo piso al lado del gimnasio.

5 preceptos de la Iglesia Católica
#1 Asistir a misa los domingos
y días de precepto

Como católicos, estamos obligados a asistir a Misa los domingos porque el domingo se considera el Día del Señor y el día de la resurrección de Jesús. Es un tiempo para el culto comunitario, para unirse y recibir a nuestro Señor en la Eucaristía y para escuchar al Señor en las Sagradas Escrituras. Esta práctica conecta a los católicos con la historia de la iglesia y las enseñanzas de Jesucristo.

Aquí hay una mirada más detallada a las razones por las que asistimos a Misa cada fin de semana:

- **La resurrección de Jesús:** El domingo se conmemora la resurrección de Jesús, el evento central de nuestra fe cristiana.
- **Adoración comunitaria:** La misa del domingo es una reunión de nuestra comunidad cristiana para adorar a Dios juntos.
- **Cumplir con una obligación:** La Iglesia Católica ve la misa dominical como una obligación moral, una forma de honrar a Dios y recibir su gracia.
- **Alimento espiritual:** La Misa proporciona alimento espiritual a través de la Eucaristía, las lecturas de las Escrituras y la homilía. La Eucaristía es la "fuente y cumbre" de nuestra vida cristiana.
- **Testimonio de fe:** Asistir a Misa es una forma de afirmar públicamente la propia fe y pertenencia a la Iglesia.
- **Renovación y esperanza:** La misa dominical ofrece un recordatorio del amor de Dios y la promesa de la resurrección, brindando esperanza y aliento para la semana que comienza.
