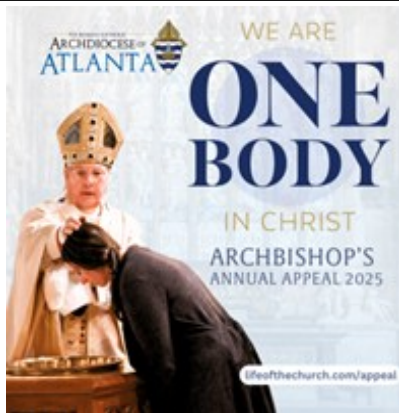

First Reading: Acts 2:1-11
Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13
or Romans: 8:8-17
Gospel: John 20:19-23

Focus

The Holy Spirit transformed the disciples into courageous witnesses of the Resurrection of our Lord. It is this same Spirit that we have received at baptism and whose fullness is given to us at confirmation so that, like those first disciples, we might build up the Church. But submitting to the power of the Holy Spirit can be challenging and we can be tempted to resist. Let us ask the Lord to give us hearts that are docile to the work of the Spirit in us.

Liturgy of the Word

In the first reading, the Holy Spirit descends upon the disciples with a powerful sound and upon each one in *tongues as of fire*. Filled with this Spirit, they begin to speak about God's works in different languages so that visitors to Jerusalem are able to understand them. Paul writes about the way the Holy Spirit animates and unites the members of the Body of Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus appears to his disciples, blesses them with his peace, and empowers them with the Holy Spirit to forgive and retain sins.
