Focus

Hope and trust in the Lord ease our sorrow for the loss of our loved ones.

The loss of a loved one brings with it sorrow due to a deeply felt absence in our daily life. We mourn the separation, even when it was not unexpected. But the pain of our loss is tempered and eased by our hope and trust in the Lord, in his mercy, and in his promise to grant eternal life to those who believe in him. We cooperate with him by praying for those who have died and asking the Lord to bring them swiftly to himself.

Liturgy of the Word

The first reading reflects on the blessed fate of the souls of the just who, after death, are in the hand of God. Paul rejoices in the love of God evidenced in Christ's sacrifice for us, which he undertook while we were still sinners. In the Gospel Jesus tells the crowd, I will not reject anyone who comes to me. He says the will of the Father is that all who see and believe in his Son have eternal life.



All Souls' Day

November 2nd

Each year on **November 2nd**, we celebrate **All Souls' Day**, also called **The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed**. It's a Holy Day when we remember loved ones who have died and pray for their souls to be at peace. As Catholics, we believe it is our duty to pray for our loved ones who have died, so that their souls can be cleansed and perfected before they enter into heaven. There is a scriptural basis for this belief. The primary reference is in **Second Maccabees 12: 26–32**:

Turning to supplication, they prayed that the sinful deed might be fully blotted out... Thus they made atonement for the dead so that they might be free from sin .

We invite each of you to share with us the names of any deceased family members and/or friends whom you would like remembered. We will place their names on the altar and will continue to pray for those who have died and remember them at all of our Masses throughout the month of November. There is no cost to submit names. However, if you wish to make a gift in memory of a loved one, please use the All Souls Day envelope found in the Narthex.



Black Catholic History Month is celebrated in November. The National Black Catholic Clergy Caucus of the United States designated November as Black Catholic History Month in 1990. The month was chosen because it includes important dates for Catholics of African descent, including:

- November 1: **All Saints Day**, a day to review the lives of the first 300 years of African saints
- November 2: **All Souls Day**, a day to remember those lost in the Middle Passage
- November 3: **The Feast Day of Martin de Porres**, the first Black American saint
- November 13: The Birthday of **Saint Augustine**

During the month of November, St. John the Evangelist will celebrate Black Catholics through art and music. Portraits of **St. Josephine Bakhita, St. Charles Lwanga, St. Martin de Porres, St. Moses the Black (The Ethiopian) and The Saintly Six** by Tracey Christianson, will be on display in the Narthex and the music selections will incorporate hymns from the *Lead Me Guide Me African American Hymnal*. Challenge your family to learn about one black saint each week. :
