### Black Catholic History Month is celebrated in November.

The National Black Catholic Clergy Caucus of the United States designated November as Black Catholic History Month in 1990. The month was chosen because it includes important dates for Catholics of African descent, including:

- November 1: **All Saints Day**, a day to review the lives of the first 300 years of African saints
- November 2: **All Souls Day**, a day to remember those lost in the Middle Passage
- November 3: **The Feast Day of Martin de Porres**, the first Black American saint
- November 13: The Birthday of **Saint Augustine**

During the month of November, St. John the Evangelist will celebrate Black Catholic History through art and music. Canvas prints, by artist Tracey Christianson, will be on display in the Narthex. Portraits included in the exhibit are: **St. Josephine Bakhita, St. Charles Lwanga, St. Martin de Porres, St. Moses the Black (The Ethiopian), and Black Saints**— a canvas print of canonized saints with 5 African Americans who are on the path to sainthood. Music selections for mass will incorporate hymns from the *Lead Me Guide Me African American Hymnal*. Challenge your family to learn about one black saint each week.

## Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome

<b>FIRST READING:</b>	<b>Ezekiel 47:1-2, 8-9, 12</b>
<b>PSALM:</b>	<b>Psalms 46:2-3, 5-6, 8-9</b>
<b>SECOND READING:</b>	<b>1 Corinthians 3:9c-11, 16-17</b>
<b>GOSPEL:</b>	<b>John 2:13-22</b>

### Focus

We are called to be God's temple, giving life to the world. In baptism, we became temples where the Spirit of God came to dwell. He remains in us so long as we do not drive him out by mortal sin; his presence influences our lives and transforms our hearts more when we put no obstacles in the way of his action. Just as Jesus drove the money-changers out of the Jerusalem temple, so we should ask him to drive out of our hearts all selfish desires so we can live fully for the glory of God and the service of others.

### Liturgy of the Word

The first reading describes Ezekiel's vision of life-giving water flowing from the threshold of the temple. The water flows into the sea, where it makes the salt waters fresh. In the second reading, Saint Paul tells the Corinthians that they are God's temple and that the Spirit of God dwells in them. In the Gospel, Jesus drives the money-changers and merchants out of the temple. Only after the Resurrection do his disciples realize that he was speaking of his body when he said, Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up.

### Centro de atención

Estamos llamados a ser templo de Dios, dando vida al mundo. En el bautismo, nos convertimos en templos donde el Espíritu de Dios vino a morar. Él permanece en nosotros mientras no lo expulsemos por pecado mortal; Su presencia influye en nuestras vidas y transforma más nuestros corazones cuando no ponemos obstáculos en el camino de su acción. Así como Jesús expulsó a los cambistas del templo de Jerusalén, así debemos pedirle que expulse de nuestros corazones todos los deseos egoístas para que podamos vivir plenamente para la gloria de Dios y el servicio de los demás.

### Liturgia de la Palabra

La primera lectura describe la visión de Ezequiel del agua vivificante que fluye desde el umbral del templo. El agua desemboca en el mar, donde hace que las aguas saladas sean frescas. En la segunda lectura, san Pablo dice a los corintios que son templo de Dios y que el Espíritu de Dios habita en ellos. En el Evangelio, Jesús expulsa del templo a los cambistas y comerciantes. Solo después de la resurrección sus discípulos se dan cuenta de que estaba hablando de su cuerpo cuando dijo: Destruid este templo y en tres días lo levantaré.
