- Advent evening prayer has been moved to the chapel.
- The HiC school family survey has been returned and results are just being compiled now. We are uncertain how the survey results will be disseminated.

Discussion: 2022-23 Goals check-in

- COVID artwork
 - o We're halfway through the feedback collection on the COVID artwork.
 - After this weekend, we'll mail the remaining ballots out and then determine the results at our Dec council meeting.
- Priest Transition
 - Transition has been seamless; agenda items are brought back and forth monthly
- Liturgical Ministers development
 - Offer something virtually and/or by recording in the future?
 - Liked the focus on "welcoming" last year, perhaps focus on "celebration" next In light of the eucharistic revival. Also with an emphasis on singing.
 - Eucharistic prayer as part of the mass emphasize the prayerfulness and conviction rather than it being a rote activity
 - Can we create a focus on worship series that highlights different aspects of the mass to the parish? Amy has a series with a yellow cover that she referenced that may be useful for a project like this. Amy will bring this topic to the staff for discussion.
- Greater engagement of community at Mass
 - o 50-80 people watch the livestream on a weekly basis
 - We are seeing an increase in in-person attendance
 - We will be calling liturgical ministers who haven't returned yet in January
 - This topic could use additional discussion
