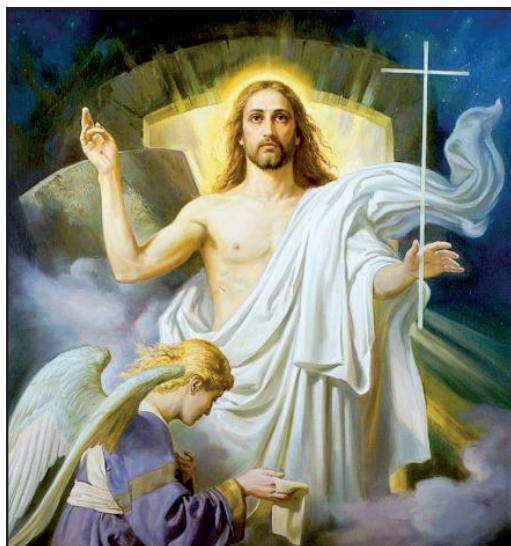

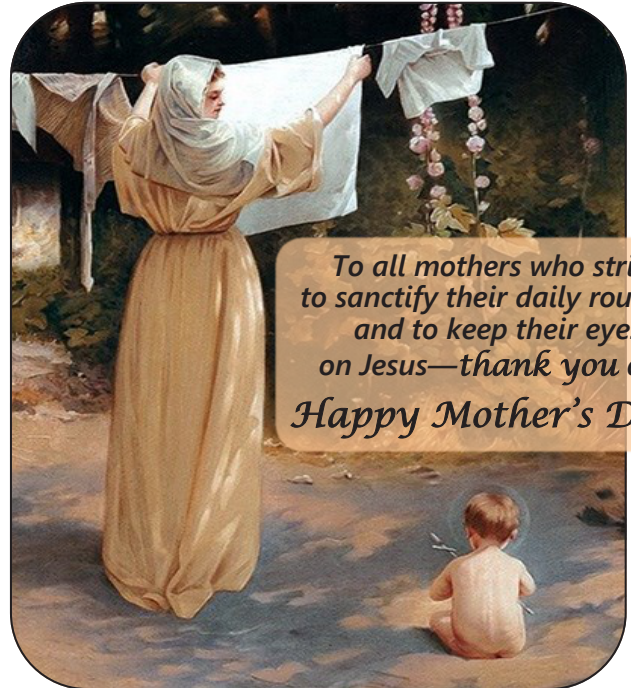
### ST. MONICA PRAYER MINISTRY

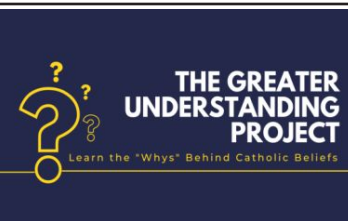


### ROSES FOR LIFE

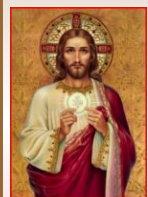
The Greater Understanding Project, a St. Maria Goretti series of in-depth talks, helps us understand and faithfully respond to commonly questioned topics in our culture or in our

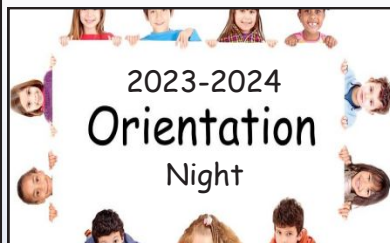

## SPIRITUAL ADOPTION PROGRAM

Our Spiritual Adoption Program has three components—daily prayer, education, and aid to mothers and babies in need in our local area. Every parishioner/family is invited to spiritually adopt a child who is in danger of abortion, a child who is newly conceived this month. Not all newly conceived babies are allowed to be born. 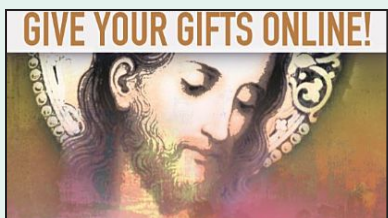
