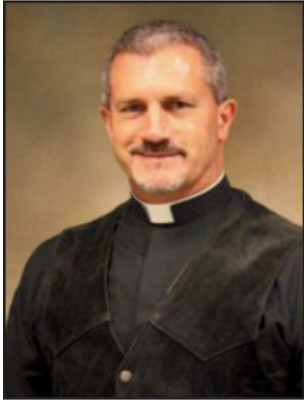

On Sunday, June 11 - the Solemnity of Corpus Christi - the Catholic Church in the United States kicks off the Parish Phase of the National Eucharistic Revival. To celebrate, **join your Brothers and Sisters in Christ from our parish and across Central Indiana** for a three-mile Eucharistic Procession (an approximate 90-minute walk) from Our Lady of Mount Carmel athletic fields to the Carter Green, located next to the Palladium in downtown Carmel. ### EARLY SAINTS MINISTRY MEETING

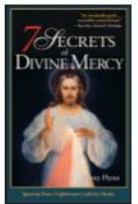

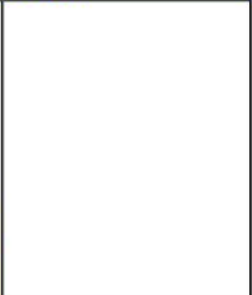


