Listen to our church bells

SMG's Bells were cast in Italy by the Marinelli family and brought over in 2017. They were installed inside the bell tower and then consecrated on December 8. Each of the five bells are named. Whenever the bells are rung, these saints are asked to pray for all those within hearing distance. The bells call the faithful to prayer (Mass and the Angelus traditionally), terrifies Satan and his demons, and brings a legion of angels to watch over the assembled Church.








## SUSAN & KEN BENDRICK




## BRING IN PALM LEAVES

#### **URGENT NEED!**

ROSARIES FOR SOLDIERS began in October 2001 at St. Elizabeth Seton Parish, when a parishioner suggested that we make rosaries like her father

had in WWII for our soldiers. We are now in our 24<sup>th</sup> year! Currently, we have 0 rosary makers at Seton, 1 in Columbus, and 1 in Logansport.

Helpers at Seton fold the prayer sheets and band them for packaging and shipping with the rosaries; package them with rosaries in plastic bags along with other materials; band holy cards; and learn quality control on rosaries received. This is a great opportunity for people with limited abilities, and most work can be done at home. Every 3-4 months boxes are packed for shipment to about 30 chaplains around the world.


## ATTENTION SENIORS: SCHOLARSHIP CHANCE



## WHAT IS THE ROSES FOR LIFE PROGRAM?

Roses for Life was initiated by an SMG couple who were so grateful for the prayers they received at another parish during their high-risk pregnancies that they wanted to establish a way to pray for mothers and their babies here at SMG, so they created the Roses for Life program for expectant mothers.

Each cream-colored rose, placed in the nave by the statue of Mary, represents a mom who is expecting a baby, either by pregnancy or adoption.

## Everyone is asked to pray for these moms and their babies.


The roses serve as a reminder to the mothers that the parish is praying for them. Each rose has the name of the mother and/or family, as well as the baby's due date. When the baby is born or adopted, the mother may take the rose as a keepsake. 


