This scholarship is intended for Saint Maria Goretti parishioners who are graduating from a public high school and are entering their first year in a college/university. The scholarship is intended to be awarded to a Canonically Confirmed parishioner(s) of SMG who has (have) demonstrated active participation in SMG, both in mass attendance and in SMG service activities and/or groups. Additional criteria include scholarly excellence, community/philanthropic service, and continued faith through high school years. This is a one-time scholarship for graduating high school students entering college. Recipients are not allowed to reapply.

Describe your continued involvement as a parishioner at SMG and a time when your involvement made a positive impact in your life (250 words maximum)

Describe how you will plan to live and grow in your faith during your college years (250 word maximum)

Provide a summary of your volunteer engagement in the community (outside of SMG) and how you were able to impact lives of others (250 words maximum)

The scholarship information, essays, and transcripts must be submitted (by email in adobe/PDF format) to Jen Downing, jen.downing@smgonline.org, at the SMG office. The applications will be reviewed by a committee of 6 members. All decisions will be reviewed by an SMG priest. Recipient(s) will be announced during a Mass (date and time to be determined) in June.
