
Volunteer Appreciation Luncheon

If you volunteer in any capacity at Cabrini Parish, we would like to honor you on Saturday, July 29. Here is a list of just some of the volunteer groups that keep us going: proclaimers of the Word, sacristans, choir, cleaners, committees, collection counting teams, altar servers, ministry workers, ushers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, coffee hour, Offering of Love, etc. Giving of your time and talent is the key to maintaining a vibrant parish. You might have noticed a Naloxone box around the outside campus of our churches. We are all aware and deeply concerned about the opioid epidemic in our community. One of the tools we have to combat this problem is Naloxone (Narcan) which, when administered in a timely, manner can, and has saved many lives. We have teamed up with the Monroe County Public Health IMPACT Team who have provided us with these boxes and who will continue to stock them at no charge to the parish.

Naloxone is a lifesaving nasal spray medication which reverses the effects of a narcotic drug overdose. The FDA approved this drug for over-the-counter use in March. These boxes hold nine kits, each with two doses of Narcan. Anyone in need can open the box and take a kit. There are directions provided on the inside of the box and on the packaging itself.

Substance abuse impacts each person's life differently. Like the use of CPR, Naloxone gives people the opportunity to improve the chance of survival of a loved one, friend, or random stranger.

To schedule a funeral please contact the parish office.





On Sunday, May 21, everyone is invited to join us for a bilingual Mass at 11am at Corpus Christi. This Mass will be followed by a provided lunch and then a presentation for people of all ages. Please plan to join us as we bring the year to a close and welcome back Father Daniel.

Please note: On May 21 there will be no English 8:30 Mass or Spanish 10am Mass - only the bilingual Mass at 11am. For those with scheduling problems, we will also have the Saturday 4pm English Mass at Annunciation, and the Sunday 11:45am Spanish Mass at Saint Michael.

We are also looking for donations of desserts and fruit. If you are willing to help us out, you can bring them to the church hall before Mass on the 21st.

We have had a great GIFT year! We began on October 9, with our first Whole Community gathering where the adults heard a talk by Father Daniel, while the children had their own age-appropriate presentations. In November we had a great morning with talks on Justice and Peace in Spanish by Father Jesús, and a talk in English by Dawn. In December we had a wonderful Advent Retreat and then an afternoon of Advent projects for families. During Lent we had a deeply meaningful Lenten Retreat facilitated by Father Daniel with time provided to use various prayer stations, and a Penance Service for our First Penance students along with our whole community. All this in addition to our regular faith formation classes for children on Saturday mornings and our Confirmation classes on Sunday nights.
