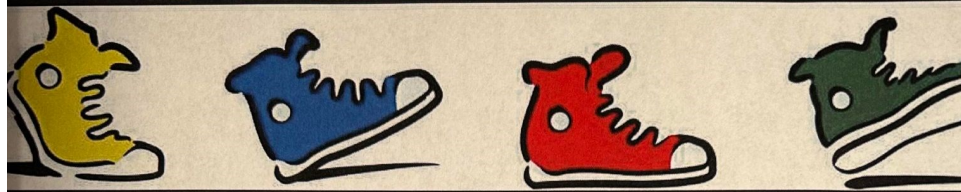

What should I do if I want something to be included in the parish bulletin?

If you want something to be included in our bulletin please submit the exact text and/or image in an **electronic format to Dawn Burdick at dawn.burdick@dor.org.**

All desired content must be submitted by 1 pm on the Monday **two weeks prior** to the first weekend you want your content to appear in the bulletin.

Keep in mind that the space is limited so try to keep your text short and to the point. We reserve the right to decide what will be included in the bulletin and/or to change the wording.

What should I do if I need a sacramental record such as a Baptismal or Holy Matrimony certificate?

Please contact the parish office at 585-3254041 Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday 9:30 am– 1 pm. Please allow for two weeks to process and receive the certificate.

Please note that Father Daniel and Father Bob cannot help you with this.

What should I do if I want something included in the church announcements?

If you want something to be included in our announcements please submit the exact text in an **electronic format to Dawn Burdick at dawn.burdick@dor.org.**

All desired content must be submitted by 1 pm on the Monday **two weeks prior** to the first weekend you want your announcement to be included.

We reserve the right to decide what will be included in the announcements and/or to change the wording, only extremely important things for the life of the parish as a whole will be included in the announcements.

What should I do if I want to make my own announcement at Mass?

If you want to make an announcement at Mass please submit the exact text of your announcement along with the desired dates and times at which you want to make the announcement to **Dawn Burdick at dawn.burdick@dor.org.**

Your text must be submitted by 1 pm on the Monday **two weeks prior** to the first weekend you want to make your announcement.

The Pastor will decide if you can make the announcement and communicate his decision to you and to the presiders of the Masses you requested to speak at. No announcements at Mass that have not been previously approved by the Pastor will be allowed.

What should I do if I have a question or an idea regarding Youth Ministry, Faith Formation or Sacramental Catechesis and Preparation?

Please do not assume you can simply use the space, you must make a reservation first so we can make sure the heat is on, and there are no conflicts.

What should I do if I want to post or distribute something at our churches?

Please submit it to Dawn Burdick two weeks prior. We reserve the right to decide if we post it/distribute it or not. You should never simply post nor distribute things that have not been approved.

What should I do if I want to have an insert placed in our bulletin?

We recommend not doing it to avoid unnecessary use of paper to better care for our common home. Inserts should only be used in unique cases. If we approve an insert the parish will not be able to either print it or stuff it, you will need to do it.
