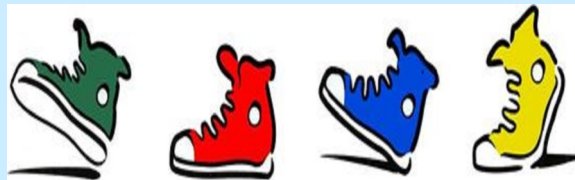
Cabrini Women's Club

How can an adult receive Baptism, First Holy Communion or Confirmation?

Are you or someone you know interested in completing one or all of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Eucharist and/or Confirmation as an adult?
