Please welcome Gloria Taveras our new Assistant for Faith Formation and Communications:



Hello, I am Gloria. Before working for the parish, I attended Corpus Christi Church when I was younger. As a child, coming back from Dominican Republic, everything else in my life changed other than God’s Love for me, so my faith was the only thing that made sense to me for a while.

I always had an eagerness to learn and be involved with my religion. I was able to deepen my knowledge in Theology and strengthen my faith while attending Nativity Preparatory Academy, for middle school and continued my education at Our Lady of Mercy School for Young Women. Later, I became a student at St. John Fisher College to study business management and accounting for two years, until COVID- 19 created more of a challenge for me.

Since I still wanted to further my education, I became a soldier for the Army National Guard and took a hiatus from being a student, where my faith was tested more than ever. While reading the book of Exodus, I witnessed several similarities between the doubt I had in my strengths and the doubt Moses had in his, on the Mountain. How he doubted that he could persuade the Pharoah to let his people go. However, when he was called to action, he was able to convince Pharoah with the power and love of God, similar to how I tried to tackle many issues I had. Building this connection between my personal life and the Bible has made my faith stronger and my need to do good for God more prevalent in my life.

I am grateful that God was able to transition me from the Catholic Courier to working for Cabrini Parish. I am blessed to be serving our Lord, Jesus Christ, and you!

What should I do if I want to make an announcement at Mass?

If you want to make an announcement at Mass please submit the exact text of your announcement along with the desired dates and times at which you want to make the announcement to **Gloria Taveras at gloria.taveras@dor.org.**

Your text must be submitted by 1 pm on the Monday **two weeks prior** to the first weekend you want to make your announcement.

The Pastor will decide if you can make the announcement and communicate his decision to you and to the presiders of the Masses you requested to speak at. No announcements at Mass that have not been previously approved by the Pastor will be allowed.

What should I do if I want to use parish space for a parish internal meeting or event such as a parish group meeting?
