**Our Partnership with Rochester Hope and Ibero Grows**  
Cabrini Parish has partnered with Rochester Hope to revitalize the Saint Michael Campus bringing much needed services to the neighborhood, such as the Service Festival, Community Meals and the Food Pantry. As part of this effort Rochester Hope and Cabrini Parish partnered with Ibero to bring their headquarters to the former Saint Michael Convent. Now, this partnership is expanding to bring Ibero's Senior Program: "Centro de Oro" to Saint Michael's former Hall, now the Saint John the Baptist, Community Center. The Senior Program will begin operations there Monday - Friday in April of 2024, while weekday evenings the space will be shared by the 3 organizations in partnership. Saturdays Rochester Hope will continue to use the space for all of their programs and Sundays Cabrini Parish will continue to use the space for parish events. Renovations of the space will begin shortly at Ibero's expense, and will be scheduled in such a way as to allow for the continuation of Rochester Hope and Cabrini Parish activities on Saturdays and Sundays. We are very happy about this new step forward in our dreams for Saint Michael, Cabrini Parish and the city and look forward to growing more and more as we learn to work together for the greater good!

How beautiful it was to see sisters and brothers celebrating together this past Sunday at Saint Michael’s for the Patronal Feast and the opening of our Faith Formation Year as well as the opening of our Parish Year of the Eucharistic Revival: ***One in Christ, Broken we Gather, Healed we are sent forth.***

To our 4 **choirs**, who with such openness and humility planned, rehearsed and ministered together for this celebration, the most profound thank you. Building unity among you is essential to building unity in the parish and you have been champions of this effort, no matter how challenging it might be.

To all the amazing people who came together from Saint Michael and Corpus Christi to **prepare and serve our meal** my, and the Lord’s endless gratitude. It is around the table, first of the Eucharist, and then of every meal that we become family. Thank you for making the effort of working together, thank you for creating the opportunity for all to come together around the table.

To our **catechists**, who have graciously moved to our new Faith Formation School at 869 N Clinton, in the hope that in this space we will be able to serve our children and youth better, and who so kindly help our children and youth grow in their faith, thank you!

To all the **other volunteers** who in the background make all this possible, thank you!

To **Gloria Taveras**, our Faith Formation and Communications Assistant, for the way in which she has fully embraced the Mission that the Lord has shared with Cabrini Parish and does all she can to contribute to that mission, thank you.
