The Voice of the Pastor

In November We Remember

During the month of November, we always remember in a special way all the faithful departed. We know that they are alive in Christ. They continue to be part of our community. Our relationships and our love are eternal. We begin the month with the Solemnity of All Saints in which we remember all the saints, the recognized ones and those that are in heaven that we might not publicly and individually recognize with feasts and memorials throughout the year. We are reminded that they are spending their time in Heaven caring and interceding for us. On November 2, we commemorate all the faithful departed, on this day we pray in solidarity with all the souls that have not yet completed their journey to heaven, and we are reminded that with the same sense of love, relationships and community with which we experience and celebrate the intercession of all the saints in Heaven for us and our mutual union and support the previous day, on this day we unite ourselves to the souls in purgatory and pray for them to complete their journey to heaven. On November 2, we can obtain a plenary indulgence for a soul in purgatory, this means their immediate transition into Heaven. To obtain this indulgence for a Holy Soul one must go to Confession, attend Holy Mass and partake in Most Holy Communion and pray for the intentions of our Holy Father Pope Francis. During this month of November, it is also customary to visit the cemeteries and pray for those buried there. As we always do, this month we will especially remember the faithful departed during all of our liturgies. For this purpose, we will light our Paschal Candle and place the Book of Remembrance with the names of the deceased next to it. We will also have our usual Mass of Remembrance, which this year will take place during the Masses on the Weekend of October 28-29, opening our month of remembrance. During the Masses of Remembrance, we will read the names of the deceased that were submitted to us for this purpose by

October 23. As we read the names, we will light candles for the deceased. All are invited to join us for these celebrations. During this month I invite all to pray in a special way for all the faithful departed. This month is also a good time to remember that we too will one day transition from this life into eternal life. It is a good time to assess our readiness for Eternal Life and to make any changes we need to make so that we can live as those whose longing is beyond the passing things of this world. This month might be a good opportunity to plan our funerals. Having preplanned our funeral both with the funeral home and with the church is a great gift for our families, which allows them more time and space for grieving instead of planning and making decisions. If you would like to preplan your funeral Mass, please contact the office. To preplan your other funeral arrangements, you should contact the funeral home of your preference. We are blessed with very good funeral homes in our area. Along with your funeral planning you will need to make arrangements for a final resting place. We encourage you to consider a Catholic cemetery as your final resting place.

A Prayer of Remembrance

God, thank you for the special people in our lives whom we are remembering in a special way during the month of November. We thank you for being a compassionate God who walks with us in our dark moments of grief and loneliness. We are thankful for all who continue to love and support us through our grief. Lord, continue to be a light for us, giving us hope, direction and courage. May we now live our lives treasuring the memories of those special people we have known and loved and help us to bring light and hope to others. We make this prayer through Christ our Lord, Amen.

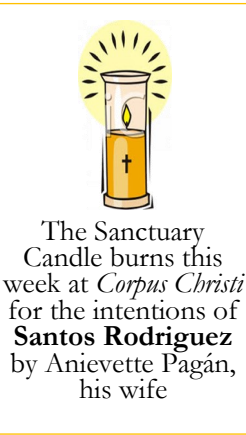
