# Children are a welcome and important part of our community

# To the parents of young children:

Welcome! We are so happy you are here. Our community loves having children with us and Father thinks that their crying, playing or making noises... their being children, is the way they praise God, so, may we suggest: Relax. God put the wiggle in children. Don't think that you have to suppress it in God's house. Consider sitting toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what's going on at the altar. They tire of seeing only the backs of the people in front of them. Quietly explain the parts of the Mass

and the actions of the priest, altar servers, proclaimers of the Word, choir, etc. The more they know about the Mass, the greater the chance that they will engage in it over time. Sing the hymns and pray the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior from copying you. If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me." Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this church.





Broken We Gather, Healed We are Sent Forth

Lent is a time to allow ourselves to become aware of God's desire and power to heal us, to make us whole, and for us to to contemplate the plate glued back together and in engage and collaborate with that process.

We will all be doing this ritual together throughout Lent the next, as we prepare to celebrate Easter.

In last week's bulletin I shared the instructions for the first gold or silver marker. three weeks of this ritual.

glue our plate together. Take a few minutes each treasure. Please give me the grace to see myself and my story day. The first day pick the first two pieces, the way you see me, as a beautiful piece of art. praverfully consider how you are already Amen. experiencing healing in these aspects of your life and glue these two pieces together saying a prayer of gratitude and continued openness to healing:

Lord Jesus, you deeply desire my healing and joy. I give you thanks for the healing you are bringing about in my life and I surrender to your continued work to set me free, in your time and in your way. I know Lord you want to heal me and you can heal me.

Amen.

You might have seen very clear sign of healing, you • might have seen only small signs, you might have seen no healing yet. In the first case, you glue to celebrate and to commit to continue to embrace and work on this healing. If there have been small • signs you can see, you glue to become more deeply aware and trust that the process will continue. If you do not see signs yet, then it is even more important to glue the pieces together and envision with Jesus what that healing looks like, as if it

already a given, trusting that it will happen. The following day glue one more piece and so on, until you complete your plate. Contemplate the glued plate and the whole healing in your life.

Week 5: March 16-24: This week we will use the gold or silver marker to go over the glue on the front of the plate, highlighting the brokenness and also the healing, as a way to celebrate our healing and to become aware of how God's love has entered our life in the midst of these situations.

This week is the biggest challenge, the most profound invitation to go beyond our fix mentality and wanting to make everything perfect, and be able to embrace the beauty of brokenness. Not everything will fit perfectly back together and there might even be small pieces missing, yet can we see the beauty of the whole? Can we see how we have grown and become more open to God and others through our challenges? The task this week then is doing this, to contemplate our whole being, our whole story, trying to see the beauty, and as we discover this beauty, to trace over the glue with our
