Weekly Meditation

We, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf. (I Corinthians 10:17)

If you buy an airline ticket, you'll have to decide between first class, with all of its fine amenities, and the more basic economy class. If you go to a play, you can choose between orchestra seating, which is right in front of the action, and balcony seating, where you may not see the actors too clearly. Similar options exist in many other places where people gather. Except, of course, for Mass. There are no different "classes of service" at the liturgy: just the whole people of God gathered as one to receive "the one loaf," which is Jesus himself (I Corinthians I0:17).

On this feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, St. Paul reminds us that we are "one body" in the Lord (I Corinthians 10:17). Jesus has called us into one community as his brothers and sisters. He has gifted all of us with the "one baptism for the forgiveness of sins" (Apostles Creed). And he has filled each of us with the same Holy Spirit that filled Mary, Peter, John, and all the saints. *Everyone* has a first-class seat! Everyone has the same high privilege of being named a child of God!

This truth is at the heart of the mystery we celebrate today: in the gift of the Eucharist, Jesus offers his whole self—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—to each and every one of us. He invites each of us to become treasured vessels of his presence: living, breathing tabernacles of his glory. He makes no distinctions, and he asks us to do the same: we are one in Christ!

Today during Holy Communion, look at the brothers and sisters gathered with you. Lift them up in prayer. Honor them as the beloved of Christ that they are. And welcome them into your heart, just as Jesus has welcomed you!

"Jesus, thank you for giving yourself to me so freely and generously!"

"What have I learned from my trips to Pacuan?

(I) People who have very little in material things find true happiness in what is really important: Faith, Family, Friendship. No need for babysitters, nursing homes, cars. Mom and Dad leaving for the day? Kids walk over to the neighbors. Grandma moves in with kids when grandpa dies. Need transport? Stand by the side of the road and the next motorcycle or truck will pick you up. Even if you have nearly nothing, you always have enough to share. (2) Our Catholic faith is universal no matter the culture. A difference in celebrating the Mass? Starting times are "Filipino time". Which means around 7:00 give or take 30-40 minutes! Offerings may include chickens, mangos or whatever can be offered. Dogs may wander in for a visit. But the Mass itself, the Liturgy of the Word, the Liturgy of the Eucharist are universal. (3) Listening to the inner voice that said "go" when logic said "no" was one of the best and most life changing decisions I made at that point in my life. Listen to yours. As I told the husband of one of the participants on a past trip who told me to "bring her back safely": I assured him I would, but that she would come back forever changed. Looking for a change in your life?"



Gospel Meditation

Years ago, a woman at daily Mass approached me in the communion procession. She had her arms crossed, indicating she wanted a blessing instead of the Sacred Host. She had tears in her eyes. I gave her a little blessing. She returned the next day. And the next. The same thing repeated. After a few weeks, I asked her why she didn't receive Holy Communion. She said she wasn't Catholic yet and was preparing to become so. I asked her why she wanted to be Catholic. She said, "Because I long to be in a real communion with Christ and with everyone I love." That, I submit, is a darn good reason. A few months later, she became Catholic and received the Body and Blood of Christ with unspeakably great joy and still does to this day.

Saint Paul says of the Eucharistic bread, "Is it not a participation in the body of Christ?" For Paul, the answer is obvious. Yes, it is exactly that. Which is why he can say, "we, though many, are one body." Jesus is truly, really, and substantially present in the Holy Eucharist. This is no magic trick, but a mystery of our salvation. He feeds us with the Sacrament of his body so that our communion with him — and with the other members of his body — is built up and becomes mature. That's why the Eucharist quenches our deep thirst for love and communion. The Body and Blood of Christ is the best reason to be Catholic. It's our participation of love in the one we love.



Miraculous Medals for St. Ignatius

A generous parishioner has donated Miraculous Medals with prayer cards to our parish, and asked them to be given to those who would like one. It was originally called the Medal of the Immaculate Conception, but so many miracles took place for people wearing the medal around their neck that soon it became known as "The Miraculous Medal".
