Weekly Meditation

Why did you doubt? (Matthew 14:31)

Isn't it interesting how doubts often pop into our heads unbidden and unwanted? Peter was actually walking on water, just like Jesus. But when he took his focus off the Lord and noticed the strong wind, doubt entered his mind: Can I really do this? That's when he started to sink (Matthew 14:30).

"Why did you doubt?" the Lord asks Peter after rescuing him (Matthew 14:31). That's a question we might ask ourselves at times. After all, we know how doubts can paralyze us, confuse us, or even lead us away from the Lord.

And yet we are all prone to doubt. When we are suffering, we might wonder whether God loves us. If we've committed a serious sin, we might question whether God will forgive us. When we get discouraged by the evil in the world, we might doubt that God is really in control.

Doubts are a natural human response to uncertainty, so we shouldn't berate ourselves for having them. Sometimes they don't even come from us; the evil one loves to plant doubts in our minds in order to shake up our faith. Whatever the case, they don't disqualify us from following Jesus. Just look at the apostle Thomas! Even a great saint like Thérèse of Lisieux struggled with doubts as she lay dying. The key is to deal with our doubts not by focusing on them but by calling out to the Lord as Peter did: "Lord, save me!" (Matthew 14:30). And just as he did for Peter, Jesus will stretch out his hand to us. He will remind us of who he is: a loving, compassionate, merciful, and mighty God. He will help us recall all he has done for us. He will assure us that he will never leave us and that nothing will ever separate us from his love.

You don't have to try to battle your doubts on your own. Jesus has come to save you—even from your doubts!

Heart to Heart Mission Team Update

Thank you to all the parishioners who financially supported our sister parish, St. Vincent Ferrer Quasi Parish in Pacuan, Philippines, through education scholarships and the clean water filter program last year.

Additional water filter systems arrived in May and are currently being delivered to the upper Barangay chapels where our Filippino brothers and sisters can access clean water. These systems are being maintained and should last for a number of years.



Once again, St. Ignatius Heart to Heart Mission Team, with the help of our parishioners, would like to support the education scholarship program for the upcoming 2023/24 school year. \$125 will support one student for the full year to cover the cost of uniforms, books, supplies, and room/board. Many of the students are parishioners from St. Vincent Ferrer who would be unable to attend school without this scholarship. 23 students received education scholarships during the 2022/23 school year at our sister parish! Because of your support, these students, altar servers, and seminarians were able to attend school or further their religious education. The requirements of the scholars included Mass attendance with a reflection journal on the Sunday's Gospel and a community clean-up day. We are excited to report that 3 scholars received academic honors for the school year!

A table will be set up in the gathering space on the weekend of August 26th and 27th to collect scholarship money. Please prayerfully consider supporting the future of a student! Any contribution, big or small is appreciated.

Gospel Meditation

A man at my parish was struggling to overcome a habitual sin. He said to me, "Father, I know the chance that I will commit sin again is really high. Why should I keep confessing my sins? Isn't that dishonest?" Anyone who has felt the tyrannical power of sin — and who hasn't? — has pondered this kind of question.

I responded to him, "What was the probability Peter would walk on the stormy water?" After some silence, he said, "Zero. But when Jesus called, he did it." I could tell my penitent friend was re-framing the question from his own weakness to the greatness of the Lord's love for him. The question for us should not be one of human probabilities about our sin, but rather whether or not we will trust the Lord's grace in our lives.

This week the Lord is calling you and me to do the impossible: overcome sin with love. The only way to do that is to trust he is calling, and then to walk with the eyes of faith locked on him. And if we sink, he will raise us up again and again. Of that, we can be 100% sure.
