A MESSAGE FROM FATHER KEVIN

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

Our readings from daily Mass this week, as well as our liturgical feasts, drew our attention to two things: priesthood and Eucharist. I'd like to reflect briefly on both.

Tuesday was the feast day of Saint John Vianney, the patron saint of parish priests. I ask for your continued prayers, that like John Vianney, I may joyfully labor for the salvation of souls all the days of my life.

Or, in his words, that I may, "give everything away and hold nothing back."

It's never been easier to do so than while being here at St. Pius X. I am frequently inspired by the kindness, devotion, and enthusiasm that so many of you have for our Lord and this parish. What a blessing to be part of this family of faith!

Here's an interesting fact about John Vianney: although he lived in the quaint town of Ars, France, pilgrims travelled from across Europe to meet him and to have him hear their confession. He often spent 18-hours a day in the confessional.

His message to pilgrims was always the same: God's love for us is greater than any sin we can commit. The Lord doesn't stand at the judgement seat wagging his finger. Rather, he gazes upon us with infinite love, seeking only one thing... our love in return.

A gentle reminder that I'm always available if anyone is seeking the grace of the Sacrament.

Secondly, a word on Eucharist.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus leads the crowds to the deepest understanding of who he is: the bread of life. "Whoever eats this bread will live forever," he says, "and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world" (John 6:51).

What an incredible gift we receive as Catholics each Sunday – Jesus himself, *the bread of life*. Just as Elijah is given bread by angels to sustain him on his journey in our first reading, so the Lord offers us Himself, fulfilling his promise, "Behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Matthew 28:20).

Dear St. Pius X Family,

I'm happy to let you all know that we've been successfully recruiting for our choirs! The young people's chorus will be called the "Day by Day Singers," inspired by the song of the same name:

A note about our prelude this weekend: Liszt *Liebestraum* No. 1, "Hohe Liebe." Liszt wrote a set of three pieces entitled "Love's Dream," each focusing on a different type of love. Earlier this year, on Valentine's Day weekend, our accompanist Craig offered No. 3 which focuses on romantic love. This week, we will hear No. 1, the accompaniment for Johann Uhland's poem "Hohe Liebe," which roughly translates to "Highest" or "Sacred Love." The gospels and readings these six weeks are taking us on a deep dive into the mystery of the broken bread, the Eucharist. Much of our music has focused on this theme, not just the communion hymns, for that reason. I pray this prelude offering prepares your heart for understanding more fully the "Hohe Liebe" that is the Eucharist, our Savior in bread and wine.
