#### THE GREAT MEANS OF OUR SALVATION

In the Holy Eucharist, Jesus Christ opens unto us many and rich fountains of grace. **St. Ambrose**, the illustrious Bishop of Milan and a great Doctor of the Church, in treating of the effects of the Most Holy Eucharist, says, "In this Mystery, the Son of God satisfies all the wants of our spiritual life." In his treatise on the Sacraments, he writes:

"If you flee darkness, Jesus is the light:

If you suffer from the heat of fever, Jesus is coolness;

If you desire the healing of your wounds, he is the physician;

If you are weighed down by your iniquities, He is the peace offering;

If you need nourishment, He is food;

If you are in want of help, He is strength;

If you fear death, He is life;

If you long for Heaven, He is the way."

These words of St. Ambrose are so beautiful and contain so great an amount of instruction that it will be profitable for us to examine them more closely in order to realize what Jesus is for us in the Blessed Sacrament.
