My brothers and sisters in Christ,

I was so glad we were finally able to reveal a first rendering of the painting of the church last week! Again, this was meant to drum up excitement and to begin jogging your imagination. It is neither a complete nor final rendering; rather, an example of what is possible. Like Goldilocks, we'll wait until we get it "just right."

A special "thank you" to all who've registered for our dinner celebration and fundraiser at Florentine Gardens on November 30! All proceeds will go to painting the church and narthex. A reminder that all tickets must be purchased by November 15. There will be other opportunities to give towards this project if you're unable to attend the dinner but are still interested in getting involved. My hope in painting the church is that it not only represents us "re-imagining our future," but also reminds us of the Lord's invitation to renew ourselves spiritually. As we beautify his house, may we also magnify Him in our hearts.

I've also been working diligently on World Youth Day. In addition to the trip Cardinal Tobin has asked me to arrange in Lisbon (August, 2023), I've been tasked with creating a "local" World Youth Day experience for young people between the ages of 14 to 17 (age subject to final approval). This will happen concurrently with World Youth Day in Lisbon. The Cardinal has asked me to oversee both experiences because he views this as a direct response to the Synod on Synodality.

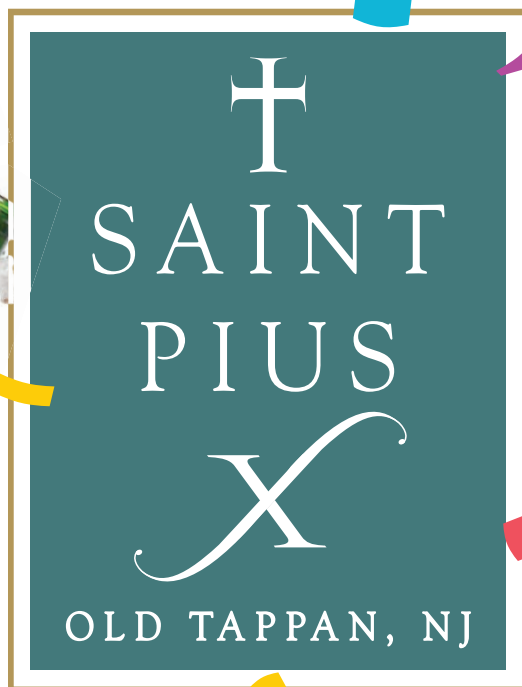

I hope and believe that World Youth Day will be an opportunity to stir belief in the hearts of our young people, while building a stronger sense of community and universal solidarity as Catholics.

MAKING DISCIPLES

FAMILY LIFE AND FAITH FORMATION NEWS

We have been working diligently to revitalize our Religious Education programs and community. One big change is that we are moving away from the terms “Religious Education” and “CCD” to **“Family Life and Faith Formation.”**

Additional improvements include upgrading our CD format TVs to **Smart TVs** that can easily access many additional Catholic faith-based resources including our **Our Sunday Visitor’s “Alive in Christ,” curriculum.** Another substantial idea is integrating **“Community Time” into all our Sunday and Tuesday classes.** This will give students the opportunity to participate in activities as a group to get to know each other a little more. We are also offering the concept of **“Adopt A Month.”** With this our Confirmation Candidates could earn Community Service hours by volunteering as aides in our fall classes. This is also extended to adult parishioners who are interested in becoming a Catechist but do not want to make the commitment for the full year.

All students in both our Summer and Fall Programs are invited to participate in our **“Pumpkin of Thanksgiving Project.”** Students who are currently in classes will be sent home with Paper Pumpkin, and students who participated in the Summer Program will be able to pick up a Pumpkin on their way out of Mass, to complete with their family. We want families to discuss with their children all the things in their daily lives that they are **thankful** for. The children will then write some of their most meaningful “thanks” onto their Pumpkins.

Students who wish to participate will then drop their pumpkins off in a basket in the Narthex (please have your child put their name and grade on the back of the pumpkin). We will then place the pumpkins onto a big Pumpkin Patch display in the Narthex for Thanksgiving.

Blank Pumpkins will be available for pick up on the weekends of November 5/6 and November 11/12. Pumpkins are due back on the weekend of November 19/20.

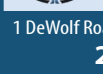
