A MESSAGE FROM FATHER KEVIN

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

Thank you to all who joined our Super Bowl Party at Florentine Gardens! I hope everyone had a great time! It was so heartwarming to see over two hundred "locals" gathered together – parishioners and nonparishioners alike – to break bread and enjoy one another's company. Even if your team didn't win, we won as a parish in the sense that this was a great community building effort. I'd like to thank Rosemarie Loffredo, our Pastoral Council chair, and Christine Clarke, our Finance Council chair, in particular for spearheading this effort.

Tom and Annie Daidone also added very generously to our victory, gifting the parish – once again – with the proceeds from our event. This week, I received a check from Tom in the amount of **\$10,000!** This will enable us to complete our painting project in the narthex. Currently, we are only scheduled to paint the church, beginning on February 27. The narthex will be addressed in the near future, but first our Buildings and Grounds Committee will do some strategic planning, developing a vision for the best utilization of that space.

A reminder that the weekend of March 4-5, we will be celebrating Mass in the narthex.... Space will be limited, so please plan accordingly. We reached out to NVOT High, but their auditorium is booked that weekend. The Mass schedule is otherwise the same.

On Monday, I had an important meeting with the parents of our children in faith formation. Whenever a full-time catechist needs coverage on a particular day s/he would reach out to all "Pinch Hitters" to find coverage, much like what the Eucharistic Ministers and lectors do for Mass. ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

St. Pius X Parishioners and guests are very fortunate to have the opportunity to experience the warm and welcoming presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament during our Holy Hour every first Tuesday of each month after the 9:00 a.m. Mass and from 5:00-7:00 p.m. All are invited to join us on Tuesday, March 7, 2023.

In a world where there is so much noise, so much bewilderment, there is need for silent Adoration of Jesus concealed in the Host. Be assiduous in the prayer of Adoration and teach it to the faithful. It is a source of comfort and light, particularly to those who are suffering.

ARCHDIOCESE OF NEWARK 2023 LENTEN REGULATIONS

 The days of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted, and two (2) smaller meals, which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal quantity.

Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast.

On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

- The obligation to observe the law of Fast and Abstinence "substantially", or as a whole, is a serious obligation.
- **3.** The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.
- The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, February 26th to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, June 4, 2023.

*Canon 920, §1. All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.
