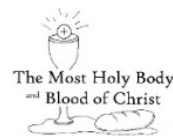

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER KEVIN

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

Our summer program has begun! This Sunday we will officially launch the program at our noon Mass, followed by our annual barbeque sponsored by the Knights of Columbus. Allow me to thank them in advance for their time, preparations, and service. I'd also like to thank our staff, catechists, volunteers, and parents for their investment in our summer faith formation program. We've been working hard over the last several months to make sure it's a success.

Our students will notice a number of changes to the program this year, which will also inform our strategic planning for our fall program. Instead of the traditional all-day instruction, our students will have the opportunity to learn through a variety of experiences such as music, art, physical education, Eucharistic Adoration, and exposure to various parts of our church. Each grade is also equipped with a Google classroom, allowing parents to follow along, and offering our students the benefit of online content.

Our fall program this year will have a similar structure to the extent that students will benefit from a combination of both in-class instruction with online access, as well as different learning experiences (music, art, etc.) peppered throughout the year. Our faith formation strategic planning committee will be learning from our students' experience in both the summer and fall programs as we seek to create a single, universal program which will be launched in the summer of 2024.

On Saturday evening, we will also welcome a new member to our parish family: Monsignor Robert Sheeran, president *emeritus* of Seton Hall University. Monsignor has been a mentor and friend for the last twenty years. He was previously celebrating Sunday Mass in Ridgewood, but has graciously decided to join us here at St. Pius X. I believe everyone will be fed by his preaching and inspired by his celebration of Mass. He will celebrate the 4:30 pm Mass this weekend and will then rotate through the Sunday Mass schedule. A reminder that the Mass schedule with the celebrant is posted on our website each weekend.

I'll conclude this week with a few reminders: Please join us for our annual golf outing at Old Tappan Golf Club on Monday, September 25. Also, save the date for next year: we will have our first golf outing at Hackensack Country Club on Monday, May 20, 2024! More details to come.

This weekend will also conclude our 50-50 raffle. The pot has risen to \$11,000! Get your ticket while you can!

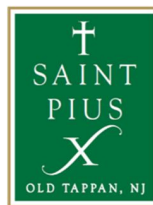
