A MESSAGE FROM FATHER KEVIN

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

By this weekend, all of the painting should be nearly finished, if not entirely finished, in the narthex, kitchen, restrooms, sacristy, and confessional. I'd like to thank Diane Alzapiedi for leading this project. Please join me in thanking her for her creativity, leadership, and time investment. The next step will be designing furniture for the narthex that allows us to maximize the space. We are looking into furniture with wheel locks, for example, so that it can be easily moved if / when necessary for various functions, etc. Exciting!

I depart for Portugal on Sunday immediately after the noon Mass. I will be travelling with Janet Natale, our Pastoral Associate, Ricardo Casimiro, my co-leader, and 42 young people ranging in age from 19-34, including four people from our parish! The group is diverse – not only in age, but also in background and experience. Together, we represent all four counties within the Archdiocese: Bergen, Essex, Hudson, and Union, and we speak six different languages: English, Arabic, Spanish, Polish, Portuguese, and Italian. Please keep all of us in your prayers. This will be a once-in-a-lifetime experience!

Perhaps what I am looking forward to the most is Saturday, August 5th, into Sunday, August 6th. Our group will join an estimated one-million other pilgrims in Lisbon, where we will spend the night outside under the stars in prayer, adoration, and conversation with other Catholics from around the world. On Sunday morning at 9 am local time, Pope Francis will celebrate an outdoor Mass. The link to watch the Mass should be available on the official World Youth Day page, as well as sources like EWTN. I'll be sure to post pictures and updates on our parish Facebook page throughout our journey. We return on August 10.

On Sunday, August 6, I'd also like to invite you to join us for Mass with Bishop Saporito! He will be celebrating a Mass at St. Pius X for peace on the anniversary of the bombing in Hiroshima. Although I'll be away in Portugal, I hope you can still join him.

May the great prophecy of Isaiah ring true now and in the days to come:

"They shall beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. One nation shall not raise the sword against another, nor shall they train for war again" (Isaiah 2:4).

On this upcoming anniversary of the bombing of Hiroshima, we not only pray for peace in Asia, but also in places ripped apart by war, including Ukraine, Sudan, and the many smaller-scale conflicts that often go unaddressed. May the Lord make us all instruments of his peace.
