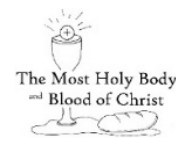
ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

blessed, sheltered and protected.

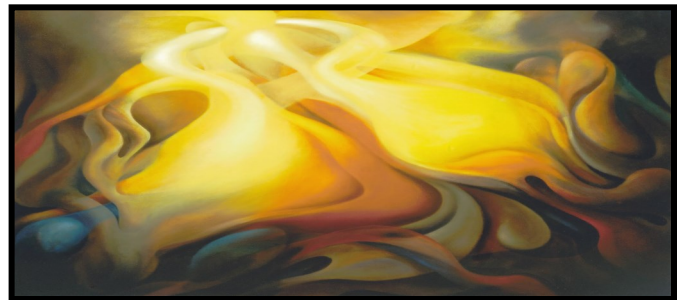
