


The Responsorial Psalm prescribed for the 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time is Psalm 145, "I will praise your name forever, my King and my God." Psalm 145 also happens to be one of the common psalms. The church has named a collection of Psalms - 27, 34, 51, 91, 95, 100 for example - as common Psalms, meaning they can be sung at any time during the year. The common psalm can replace the psalm in the lectionary for the day. The aim of the Common Psalms is to give communities a core repertoire of psalms that are well-known and can be used at any occasion, and allow the congregation to sing with confidence. We will use the common psalms, such as 145, for our 10:00 a.m. Family Liturgies with the Day By Day Singers. The setting for this Sunday by Rawn Harbor is one of my favorites, from a Gospel collection entitled, "Psalms for the Soul."

All choirs and Junior Cantor rehearsals have begun! If you have not expressed your interest, it's never too late to join. Fellowship Choir rehearses the next three Thursdays at 7:00 p.m. and then begins singing at the 12:00 p.m. Mass on October 8th.
