A MESSAGE FROM FATHER KEVIN

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

I want to thank all of you who took the time to take our parishioner feedback survey. While it will remain open and anonymous, we've exceeded our goal of 200 – we're at 227 and counting! This is the best way for me to gauge the pulse of the parish in terms of what's working, what's not working, etc. The pastoral council will also be working on a survey in the coming months which will focus on ministry, as opposed to the current survey which is largely centered around the Mass.

At this point, I'd like to begin sharing some concrete changes that will be happening directly as a result of the survey. For starters, most — if not all — of the songs that we will be singing in Ordinary Time will be selected from the 90 songs that you listed as your "favorites" in the survey. I'll include below the top 15 most popular, which does not mean they'll be the only ones we'll sing, but you'll hear them a bit more often. Please remember, however, that as we enter the season of Advent, the songs will be of the season — carols, traditional Christmas hymns, etc. The songs below will be inserted into the liturgy once we return to Ordinary Time after Christmas.


Another change you'll see is the style of music. For example, 80% of survey respondents selected the piano as an instrument that supports your participation in worship. 59% selected the guitar. 58% selected the organ. Therefore, the majority of our music will come from the piano while we'll also pepper in the organ and guitar. I've asked Debra Wyka, our interim Director of Music, to use the organ while I am at the altar during the Liturgy of the Eucharist, but to play the piano for the rest of Mass (entrance hymn, Gloria, Communion, concluding hymn). We will also try a guitar-led Mass at some point in the near future.

There are a number of other insights offered in this survey, which I'll continue to share in the weeks ahead. For now, your "favorite" fifteen hymns!
