For the last seven months, I have been patiently awaiting the arrival of a very special gift for our parish. Finally, it has arrived! We are set to install it starting on Tuesday, January 2. I am told, all things being equal, that this will be a three-day project. Meaning, we will be able to unveil it for the weekend of January 6-7, which is the Feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord. I'll leave the rest as a surprise. (Pending proper installation), the "unofficial" unveiling will be at the 4:30 pm Mass on Saturday, January 6. Monsignor Sheeran will be the celebrant at that Mass as I'll be out of town for a wedding. I will have the "official" unveiling and blessing at the 12 pm Mass on January 7. 
