Tuesday February 7 th	No Divine Liturgy 1Jn 3:10-20 Mk 14:10-42	Our Venerable Father Parthenius, Bishop of Lampsachia, died A.D. 318 during the reign of Emperor Constantine the Great — Our Venerable Father Luke, who was in Helladia of Syria.		
Wednesdy February 8 th	No Divine Liturgy 1Jn 3:21-4:6 Mk 14:43-15:1	St. Theodore, the Great Martyr, was a general in the army of the Emperor Licinius. He suffered death at Heraclea in Thrace A.D. 318. — St. Zacharias, the Prophet, was one of the tribe of Levi 520 B.C.		
Thursday February 9 th	No Divine Liturgy 1Jn 4:20-5:21 Mk 15:1-15	St. Nicephorus, Martyr, a Syrian Christian, took the place of Sapricius, who apostatized before a heathen judge and was put to death A.D. 260, during the reign of Emperor Valerian		
Friday February 10 th	No Divine Liturgy 2Jn 1-13 Mk 15:22.25&33-41	St. Charalampus, Martyr, endured death by the sword A.D. 203 at Magne. in Asia Minor, in the hegemony of Lucinianus, in the reign of Emperor Septimius Severus.		
Saturday February 11 th	4:00pm Vesper Divine Liturgy Intention: Sarah Boga conversion and liberation 1Cor 10:23-28	St. Blasé, Bishop-Martyr, suffered martyrdom A.D. 316, at Sebaste, by beheading, during the hegemony of Licinius, in the reign of Constantine the Great, Emperor.

Reinstated in 378, he held a council of 150 Bishops and took prominent part in the Council of Constantinople A.D. 380, in the reign of Theodosius the Great. — St. Marina, Virgin, in male attire, lived in the monastery to the year A.D. 440.
