

Instruction is generally seen as positive.


Safety concern about kids running into the streets at end of the program.

The addition of greeters is seen as positive but they need to be better trained.


Comments about perceptions of insiders vs. outsiders.

Youth Ministry




Turnover in the leadership of this program is seen as a problem.

The challenge of reaching all students was presented.


Parish Communications

Comment Analysis

Sacred Heart Could Improve By:

- Offering more programming and retreats.
- Getting more people involved.

Helping you become more involved in the parish.

- •The general perception is that there is good involvement.
- •Some suggest getting retirees more involved, they have the time.
- •Others felt that recent improvements in parish operations would generate new interest in getting involved.

Closer relationship between you/ your family and Christ.

- Several suggestions to expand local programming such as workshops and retreats.
- Others support continuing the new programs recently started in the parish.
- Still others suggested to make all feel welcome.

Greatest challenges facing the parish.

- Meeting long-term financial obligations.
- Getting and keeping the young involved.

Bringing back non-practicing Catholics.

- Many participants urged prayer and keeping the doors open for those who have fallen away.
- Some respondents suggested following the Holy Fathers path of acceptance.
- Other respondents suggested personal visits by the clergy to those who have fallen away.

The Light of Christ in the community.

- Some respondents urged that we enhance our presence in the community by working with the poor and marginalized.
- Others suggested that we get all of our parish youth involved in community service projects.
