Child: Who should I pray for today?

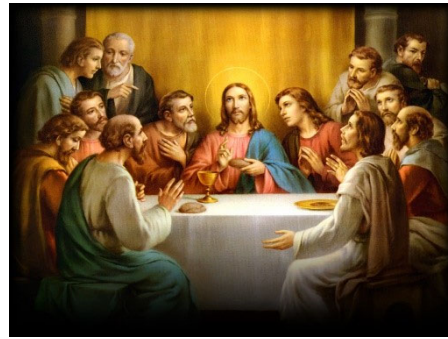
PREPARING FOR SUNDAY: OUR WEEKLY SCRIPTURES

Pentecost Sunday

Next week, with the celebration of the coming of the Holy Spirit (Pentecost), fifty days after Easter, we will conclude this amazing season of joy and grace. However, we will not stop singing alleluia. The Easter Season gives us the boost to continue to uncover the goodness of God throughout the year in the liturgical Solemnities and the counted (Ordinary) Sundays that will follow. The feast we will celebrate next week is two fold: it is the celebration of when the Holy Spirit made his dwelling place in the hearts of the disciples and turn them on fire for Christ, and it is also the birthday celebration of the Church. The Spirit coming on the Apostles dispelled their fears and with that 2000+ years later 2.2 billion people are calling Jesus Christ their Lord and Savior. In preparation for this amazing feast, please read the following scripture passages: Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11; Psalm 104; 1 Corinthians 12:3B-7, 12-13; John 20:19-23.

Remember to **wear red** to show that you got the Spirit!

FROM THE PASTORAL STAFF



Dear Parishioners:

On June 19, 2022 at 10:00 a.m., our Parish will celebrate the Feast of THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI). This is the first of four installments to address the Eucharist in the Life of the Church and here at St. Clare's.

PART I: THE REAL PRESENCE- It started at the Last Supper

As Catholics, we believe that Christ is present in many ways to His Church. In the Priest who presides over the Eucharist, in the proclamation of the Word and when two or three are gathered in His name. We also believe that Jesus is present in a special way in the sacred species of bread and wine. This is of course a mystery in our faith. The word "*Mystery derives from a Greek word meaning 'to close one's eyes and lips.' So, a mystery is a reality that is present even when our eyes are closed- that is, when we cannot see or understand it.*" (Fr. Benedict Groeschel, CFR)

The source of the mystery of the Real Presence of Jesus can be traced back to Holy Thursday and the scene of the Last Supper. During the meal, Jesus offers himself to the Father for our salvation when he says, "*This is my body which is given up for you. This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in memory of me.*"

Our faith teaches us that these words mean that Jesus will be with us present in the Eucharist for all time. The Church has arranged the entire celebration of the Liturgy of the Eucharist in parts corresponding to precisely these words and actions of Christ. At each Mass, we are called to relive the sacrifice at Calvary and re-present the Sacrifice of Jesus over and over.

At this same meal, Jesus instituted the Priesthood and the power of the Priest acting "in persona Christi" or "*in the person of Christ.*" (*During consecration & Sacrament of Reconciliation*) Thus, when the church celebrates the Eucharist, the action of the priest and community in union with the Holy Spirit brings about what is proclaimed and makes real what has been promised. The Church uses the term "*transubstantiation*" to express that at the consecration of the Mass, the bread and wine change into the reality of Jesus. These beliefs are part of the Catholic faith and supported by the Council of Trent.

"*That in this sacrament are the true Body of Christ and his true Blood is something that cannot be apprehended by the senses,*" says St. Thomas, "*but only by faith, which relies on divine authority.*" While the real presence remains a mystery, it is one of the gifts of our Catholic faith that yields us many graces and is a source of strength for all believers.

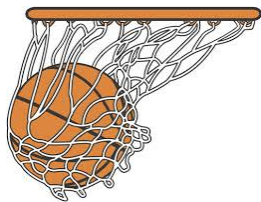
