## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESKTOP

This coming Friday is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to which the whole month of June is dedicated.

One of my childhood memories is of one of the priests of the parish coming to enthrone the image of the Sacred Heart in our home. The names of my parents and of my brother and I were inscribed on the scroll at the bottom of the picture. In subsequent years, my dad added the names of the further four siblings that would be born as the fruit of their nuptial union. We would gather in front of that image for prayer.



The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart comes at the end of the Octave of Corpus Christi—the feast of Corpus Christi in the Universal Calendar of the Church being last Thursday. It is only natural that the celebration of the great mystery of the Eucharist is recognized as a gift of the Jesus' Sacred Heart, burning with love for us. It is also not surprising that St. John Paul II established the feast of the Sacred Heart as an annual *World Day of Prayer for Priests*. A priest's true identity is found only in the full identity of his heart with the heart of Christ. Every day after Mass I pray: "*O bone Iesu, fac ut sim sacerdos secundum Cor tuum.*" "*O good Jesus, grant that I be a priest according to your Heart.*" Here is an indulgenced *Prayer for a Holy Life* that a priest may say daily:

Dearest Jesus, who of Thy great goodness hast called me to be Thy follower in preference to countless others and hast raised me to the high dignity of Thy priesthood, bestow upon me abundantly, I pray, Thy divine help in fulfilling my duties in a right spirit. I beseech Thee, Lord Jesus, to stir up in me Thy grace both today and always, that grace which is in me by reason of the laying on of hands of the bishop. O mighty Physician of souls, heal me in such wise that I may never be entangled in sinful habits, but that I may renounce them all and be enabled to please Thee even to the day of my death. Amen. (From *The Raccolta*)

Here is a prayer for priests of St. Therese of the Child Jesus that I invite you offer for me and for all priests:

O Jesus, I pray for your faithful and fervent priests; for your unfaithful and tepid priests; for your priests laboring at home or abroad in distant mission fields; for your tempted priests; for your lonely and desolate priests; for your young priests; for your dying priests; for the souls of your priests in purgatory.

But above all, I recommend to you the priests dearest to me: the priest who baptized me; the priests who absolved me from my sins; the priests at whose Masses I assisted and who gave me your Body and Blood in Holy Communion; the priests who taught and instructed me; all the priests to whom I am indebted in any other way (especially ...).

O Jesus, keep them all close to your heart, and bless them abundantly in time and in eternity. Amen.

**NEW TABERNACLE AT SPB**

A beautiful new tabernacle has been installed at St. Philip Benizi, a gift from Mrs. Jamilh Toukatli. It was blessed and the Blessed Sacrament reserved in it for the first time during Mass last Sunday, the Feast of the Blessed Trinity. The door depicts the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph,



overshadowed by the Holy Spirit. Inside is a medallion with the words “Adore te devote”, meaning “Devoutly I adore thee”, the first words of St. Thomas Aquinas’ beautiful Eucharistic hymn, rendered in English hymnals as “Godhead here in hiding” or “Humbly we adore thee.” May God reward Mrs. Toukatli and please offer a prayer for her and her intentions as you bend the knee before our Eucharistic Lord.
