2021
2023

The biggest listening and discussion event the Church has ever undertaken is happening in the Archdiocese of Baltimore and across the globe. It is called Synod 2021-2023. Pope Francis and Archbishop William Lori are inviting all Catholics, all people of other faith traditions and people of good will to participate, pray, reflect and share thoughts and ideas.

Synod discussion and listening sessions are being conducted in every local Catholic Church. Catholic parishes in the Archdiocese of Baltimore are holding prayerful listening sessions where the feedback will be compiled and delivered to Pope Francis. The local phase of the Synod began in October 2021 and will close by Easter 2022. The larger regional and global process then begins. The goal of the Synod is to make sure people are heard and to discern the ways that we are all journeying together as a Church.

La fase local del Sínodo comenzó en octubre de 2021 y se cerrará en la Pascua de 2022. Entonces comenzará un proceso regional y global más amplio. El objetivo del Sínodo es asegurarse de que las personas sean escuchadas y discernir las formas en que todos caminamos juntos como Iglesia. ¡Caminemos juntos!

FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR...

The third pillar of Lent is almsgiving or acts of mercy and love.

Almsgiving and acts of mercy are ways in which we tell God that we will not be possessed by our possessions, but are ready and willing to share our possessions or valuable time in the service of others.

During Lent, we make a special effort to do acts of charitable service or take up collections of food or clothing for those in need.

How almsgiving can help guide your Lenten journey:

- Throughout Lent, save up your loose change in a jar and donate to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul to our Parish.
- Volunteer once a week to help others. Donate food to a local food pantry each week.
- Stop by a nearby nursing home, and spend an hour visiting with the residents.
- Make cards for those who are sick, shut-in, or incarcerated; let them know someone cares.
- Perform one act of random kindness every day for a week.

So, as one of the three pillars of Lenten practice, almsgiving is "a witness to fraternal charity" & "a work of justice pleasing to God." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2462).

Solemnity of the Annunciation and Incarnation of

Our Lord Jesus Christ

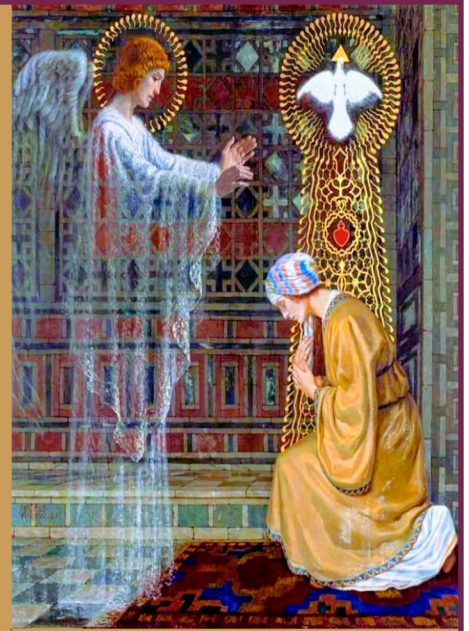
March 25

Each year on March 25, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. This great feast takes its name from the tidings announced by the angel Gabriel to the Blessed Virgin Mary concerning the Incarnation of the Son of God.

The Annunciation has its main focus on the Incarnation:

God became man to save us through the “Yes” of Mary.

In Pope Francis's words: “Today is the celebration of the ‘yes’. Indeed, “in Mary’s ‘yes’ there is the ‘yes’ of all of salvation history and there begins the ultimate ‘yes’ of man and of God: there God re-creates, as at the beginning, with a ‘yes’, God made the earth and man, that beautiful creation: with this ‘yes’ I come to do your will and more wonderfully he re-creates the world, he re-creates us all”. It is “God’s ‘yes’ that sanctifies us, that lets us go forth in Jesus Christ”. This is why today is the right day “to thank the Lord and to ask ourselves: am I a man or woman of ‘yes’ or a man or woman of ‘no’? Or am I a man or woman who looks away, so as not to respond?”.

SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS

Confessions: Every weekday morning after Mass in the Basilica you may ask the Priest for confession. Saturdays from 4-4:45 p.m.

Marriage: Couples must arrange their wedding ceremony at least 6 months beforehand. Every couple must attend a Pre-Cana meeting.

Wedding Livestream is now available: Please contact the rectory if interested.

Sacrament of the Sick: If you know you are going to be hospitalized, consider receiving the Sacrament of Anointing beforehand at any weekday Mass. Ask the priest before Mass in the sacristy.

Baptism: Parents wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism with their children must attend a "Registration and Instruction Session" on the First Saturday of any month at 11 am in the Basilica Conference Center. At these sessions, it will be necessary for both parents to attend, and to bring a copy of the baby's birth certificate. Necessary registration forms will be completed, the required instruction will take place, and the Baptism will be scheduled. Remember, both Godparents must be Catholic, 16 years old, and must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Godparents may attend these sessions but are not required.

Baptisms are celebrated in English on the third Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica.

Once this session is completed, you may schedule the ceremony for any month.

Baptisms are celebrated in Spanish on the second Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica. Spanish "Registration and Instructions"

on the first Friday evening at 7:30 p.m. in the Basilica Conference Center.

It is no longer necessary to come to the Rectory Office to set up a Baptism celebration. We also have Chinese and Italian Baptisms.

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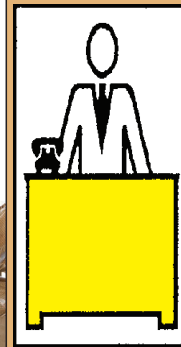


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
