





St. Vincent de Paul Society Christ the King Conference

This is a generous parish. The St. Vincent de Paul ministry has been active at Christ the King since 1933, thanks to the continued support of you! This ministry provides assistance with food, clothing, bus tickets, furniture, rent and utilities to our neighbors in need. The SVDP on-call teams, two or three members, make home visits to the clients to determine how best to help in response to their request for help. We help single parent families, low-income families, low-income veterans, families fleeing domestic violence, and many with disabilities. A large percentage of those helped are children. Our mission is to serve the poor and we are humbled to do this. In August we were able to help a grandmother suddenly responsible for two teenage granddaughters after a tragedy in the family sent the mother to prison. "There but for the grace of God go I."

We partner with the Aurora SVdP Thrift Store, 13555 Aurora, just north of Office Depot. Sales directly benefit St. Vincent de Paul. Please stop by and take advantage of the great sales every day.

There is usually a second collection at the Masses on the second weekend of the month to benefit the St. Vincent de Paul ministry. We depend on these funds to help our neighbors in need. 99% of all the money collected, both in the plate collection and the on-line giving, are used for the poor. The other 1% is used for any administrative needs of the conference – nametags, stamps, etc. Members donate their time and their gas.

This weekend the second collection will be taken for the Maryknoll Missionaries. We hope you are generous as the Maryknoll ministry is important. But, please keep us in mind next Sunday. Thank you in advance for your continued generous support of St. Vincent de Paul.
