CONSECRATION TO MARY

Have you ever considered Consecration to Mary?

We will be following the preparation process to consecration on July 20th when the image of our Lady of Fatima visits our parish. We will be following the book "33 Days to Morning Glory" by Fr. Gaitley, and it will require reading daily and meeting weekly for DVD teaching by Fr. Gaitley and group discussion for 6 weeks.

What is Marian Consecration?

The simplest of terms, by means of Marian consecration, we give ourselves to Mary to be formed into the image of her Son, Jesus. Saint Louis de Montfort (1673-1716), author of the seminal book on Marian consecration, *True Devotion to Mary*, described total consecration to Jesus through Mary as "the surest, easiest, and most perfect means" to becoming a saint.
