Attention Parents of 1st & 2nd graders!

If your child plans to receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist in May 2018 or May 2019, please note the following important steps to correspond with Archdiocese guidelines.

Current 2nd Graders attending any school (including CKS and public schools):

Classes will be held on Wednesday evenings beginning in early October. These should be attended with a parent or guardian. In addition, children must attend Sunday School on Sunday mornings between the Masses beginning in early October.

Current 1st Graders attending Christ the King or another Catholic grade school:

Children are strongly encouraged to attend Sunday School beginning in early October for two consecutive years to prepare for receiving the sacraments the second year. During the second year (2018-19 school year), students and parents are required to attend Wednesday evening sacramental prep classes and Sunday morning Sunday School classes.

Current 1st Graders attending a public or private (non-Catholic) school:

Children are REQUIRED to attend Sunday School beginning in early October 2017 for two consecutive years to prepare for receiving the sacraments the second year. During the second year (2018-19 school year), students and parents are required to attend Wednesday evening sacramental prep classes.
