Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

This weekend we celebrate Catechetical Sunday within the parishes and a new year of our Religious Education program. What is the purpose of catechesis and religious education? Part of it has to do with learning about the teachings of the faith: we study the creed, the Holy Trinity, the life of Jesus (especially his death and resurrection), the sacraments, Mary and the saints, the Church, the call to justice, and our hope for eternal life. There is a lot to learn about our faith—even for adults. But, more than that, catechesis is meant to draw us into a deeper relationship with Jesus himself (and with our brothers and sisters within the community). Our lives will echo the life of Christ the more we come to know him and love him. Special thanks today to all our catechists who give of their time to witness to the faith!

Today's Gospel speaks of the disciples' ambitions. Too often ambition can be self-centered; then it leads to jealousies, bitter disputes, infighting, even violence among individuals; it can lead to racial and religious hatred and wars on a wider level. But Jesus tells us that, as his followers, our greatest ambition should be to serve. Are we eager, ambitious, to serve the poor, the weak, the neediest? Serving others may not offer us glamorous jobs or titles—but we will be putting his teachings into practice. And that is what truly counts in the long run—following in the footsteps of Jesus.

Este fin de semana celebramos el Domingo Catequético en nuestras parroquias y también un nuevo año de nuestro programa de Educación Religiosa. ¿Cuál es el propósito de la catequesis y de la educación religiosa? Ambos tienen que ver con aprender las enseñanzas de nuestra fe: estudiamos el Credo, la Santísima Trinidad, la vida de Jesús (especialmente su muerte y resurrección), los sacramentos, aprendemos acerca de la Virgen María y los santos, la Iglesia, el llamado a la justicia y nuestra esperanza de vida eterna. Hay mucho que aprender sobre nuestra fe, incluso para los adultos. Pero, más que eso, la catequesis está destinada a llevarnos a una relación más profunda con Jesús (y con nuestros hermanos y hermanas dentro de la comunidad). Nuestras vidas harán más eco de la vida de Jesucristo cuanto más lo conozcamos y lo amemos a Él. ¡Un agradecimiento especial hoy a todos nuestros catequistas que dan de su tiempo y trabajo para dar testimonio de la fe!

El Evangelio de hoy nos habla de las ambiciones de los discípulos. Con demasiada frecuencia, la ambición puede ser egocéntrica y conducir a celos, amargas disputas, luchas internas, e incluso a violencia entre individuos; puede conducir al odio racial y religioso y a guerras a un nivel más amplio. Pero Jesús nos dice que, como seguidores suyos, nuestra mayor ambición debe ser el servir. ¿Anhelamos y luchamos por servir a los pobres, a los débiles, a los más necesitados? Servir a los demás puede que no nos ofrezca títulos glamorosos, pero al hacerlo pondremos en práctica las enseñanzas de Cristo. Y eso es lo que realmente cuenta a largo plazo: seguir los pasos y el ejemplo de Jesús.

We received the following notice from our diocese:

VACCINATIONS: RELIGIOUS EXEMPTIONS FOR CATHOLICS

Please note that **there is no basis for a religious exemption for the Covid-19 Vaccines in the Catholic Church.** The Holy See has stated that there is no moral objection to any of the vaccines currently in use. Therefore, there are no circumstances in which a pastor or any priest in the Diocese can write an exemption on religious grounds.

Pastors and all priests are not to provide people with a so-called “religious exemption.” Individuals are free to decide for themselves whether they wish to be vaccinated or not, but the Church does not issue exemptions on religious grounds for Covid-19.

We urge all our parishioners to consult with their doctors and get vaccinated as soon as possible. Pope Francis said: “Getting a Covid vaccine is an act of love. Helping others do the same is also an act of love. Love for oneself, love for our families and friends, and love for all peoples. It is a simple yet profound way to care for one another, especially the most vulnerable.”

Recibimos el siguiente aviso de nuestra diócesis:

VACUNAS: EXENCIONES O DISPENSACIONES RELIGIOSAS PARA CATÓLICOS

Por favor tengan en cuenta que **no existe ninguna base para una exención o dispensación religiosa para las vacunas Covid-19 en la Iglesia Católica.** La Santa Sede ha declarado que no hay objeción moral a ninguna de las vacunas actualmente en uso. Por lo tanto, no hay circunstancias en las que un párroco u otro sacerdote de la Diócesis pueda escribir una exención por motivos religiosos.

Los párrocos y todos los sacerdotes no están autorizados para proporcionar a las personas la llamada “exención religiosa”. Las personas son libres de decidir por sí mismos si desean vacunarse o no, pero la Iglesia no emite exenciones por motivos religiosos para el Covid-19.

Instamos a todos nuestros feligreses a consultar con su médico y a vacunarse lo antes posible. El Papa Francisco dijo: “Recibir una vacuna contra el Covid-19 es un acto de amor. Ayudar a otros a hacer lo mismo también es un acto de amor. Amor por uno mismo, amor por nuestras familias y amigos, y amor por todos los pueblos. Es una manera simple pero profunda de cuidarnos los unos a los otros, especialmente a los más vulnerables”.
