## ***Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco***

Dear Friends,

As we gather in church this week, we hear some familiar words from Scripture—the Beatitudes. But they may sound a little different to us, because in Luke’s Gospel, there is a contrast set between four “blessings” and four “woes.” For me, the Beatitudes are always Jesus’ way to shake us up a bit, to get us to look at things differently. Jesus offers a different view of the world—and he wants us to see what really matters, and who really matters. There are some inevitable costs involved in discipleship; when we unite our lives to Christ there will be some suffering and hardship, some serious challenges. The blessing that Saint Luke talks about is not in the suffering itself—it comes from knowing that we are united to Christ. And as we make it our aim to serve the poor, the hungry and the sorrowing, we also become more like Christ himself. That is the real blessing, the real beatitude.

Have you seen these beatitudes in your own life? Have you been able to see Christ in the poor and the sorrowing, in your family or among your neighbors, and found a way to reach them? May we see the opportunities we have to serve others in need, and so bear witness to the God of life and love.

Para mí, las bienaventuranzas son una manera que Jesús usa para sacudirnos un poco, para hacernos ver las cosas de otra manera. Jesús nos ofrece una visión diferente del mundo, y quiere que pongamos atención a lo que realmente importa y a quién realmente importa. Hay algunos costos inevitables involucrados en el discipulado; cuando unimos nuestras vidas a Cristo habrá algunos sufrimientos y dificultades, algunos fuertes desafíos. A lo que refiere San Lucas cuando dice "Dichosos" no es que haya dicha en el sufrimiento mismo, sino la dicha viene al estar unidos a Cristo. Y a medida que hacemos nuestro objetivo el servir a los pobres, a los hambrientos y afligidos, también nos hacemos más como Cristo mismo. Esa es la verdadera bendición, la verdadera dicha, la verdadera bienaventuranza.

¿Han visto estas bienaventuranzas en su propia vida? ¿Han podido ver a Cristo en los pobres y en los que sufren, en su familia o vecinos, y han encontrado la manera de llegar a ellos y ayudarlos? Ojalá que podamos notar las oportunidades que se nos presentan de servir a otros en necesidad, y así dar testimonio del Dios de la vida y el amor.


