#### Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

As we gather in church this week, we hear some familiar words from Scripture—the Beatitudes. But they may sound a little different to us, because in Luke's Gospel, there is a contrast set between four "blessings" and four "woes." For me, the Beatitudes are always Jesus' way to shake us up a bit, to get us to look at things differently. Jesus offers a different view of the world—and he wants us to see what really matters, and who really matters. There are some inevitable costs involved in discipleship; when we unite our lives to Christ there will be some suffering and hardship, some serious challenges. The blessing that Saint Luke talks about is not in the suffering itself—it comes from knowing that we are united to Christ. And as we make it our aim to serve the poor, the hungry and the sorrowing, we also become more like Christ himself. That is the real blessing, the real beatitude.


Have you seen these beatitudes in your own life? Have you been able to see Christ in the poor and the sorrowing, in your family or among your neighbors, and found a way to reach them? May we see the opportunities we have to serve others in need, and so bear witness to the God of life and love.






