Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

What do you think? Do we take the opportunities presented to us to love our neighbor, to learn about the love of Jesus, to take time to deepen our Catholic faith, and even to bear witness to God in our lives?

There is no time like the present—and when Moses heard the Lord speaking to him from the burning bush, he knew that he had to answer, to take off his shoes, and recognize the presence of God on holy ground! God had called him by name, and called him to lead his people to freedom. The Exodus story is ours as well. We journey with the Church throughout the season of Lent, and we seek to be freed from our sin, from whatever holds us back from serving God and neighbor. God calls out to each of us, calling us to conversion and change of heart, inviting us to live our faith in him—starting today—because there is no time like the present!

So let us take the opportunities Lent offers us. We can take time for prayer by making more time for Mass, or joining in prayer for Eucharistic Adoration at our Lenten reflections, or by using the “Little Books” distributed at the beginning of this season. We can gather together for the Stations of the Cross when it is offered. We can celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation (with extra availability around all of Brooklyn and Queens on April 11th, “Reconciliation Monday.”)

Queridos amigos,



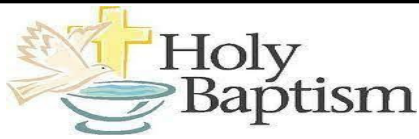

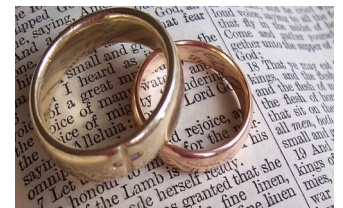

Practicing Generosity

Generosity is an attitude. It is a sense that no matter how much I have, all that I have is gift, and given to me to be shared. It means that sharing with others in need is one of my personal priorities. That is quite different from assessing all of my needs first, and then giving away what is left over. **A spirit of self-less giving means that one of my needs is to share what I**



have with others. Lent is a wonderful time to practice self-less giving, because it takes practice. This kind of self-sacrificing generosity is a religious experience. It places us in solidarity with the poor who share with each other, without having any excess. It also joins us with Jesus, who gave himself completely, for us. Establishing new patterns of giving will give real life and joy to Lent.
