Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

The last few weeks, we have seen Jesus speaking in parables that were long and complex, and sometimes it was difficult to find the point of his message. But today he speaks simply to the Apostles and gives them a graphic image that is very easy to grasp. Think of how many pictures you have seen with an open hand holding mustard seeds, or the image of the seeds and the grown tree. The thing is, those photos are worth a thousand words. One could call it the “elevator pitch” on faith. Jesus provides his followers with a touchstone to hold onto, a spiritual roadmap as it were. But along with that beloved parable is a more difficult message.

REMEMBER WHO YOU ARE

At some point, Jesus must just get exasperated with these folks. The Apostles and disciples have been following him for how long now? And they still don’t understand. The kingdom of God is not about how great you are on earth, or how much faith you have. There is much work to be done. He reminds them that they are still the folks who are going to be cooking dinner when they come home in the evening. They are the servants. Their work continues until the kitchen is clean! Similarly, it is not enough for us to simply show up to church on Sunday morning. We must be servants in our daily lives. On my computer screen is a yellow sticky note that says “If serving is below you, then leadership is above you.” Right now, “Servant Leadership” is a big buzzword phrase bordering on overuse, but there is a lot of truth to it. Some of the ways we may lead our families, our workgroups, our faith groups include: listening to others, showing empathy, healing yourself through work-life balance, developing your self-awareness, and being a good steward. Wrap it any way you want, it is all about being a good Christian. Have faith. Serve others. Watch it grow!

Vigésimo Séptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

En las últimas semanas, hemos visto a Jesús hablar en parábolas largas y complejas, y a veces era difícil encontrar el sentido de su mensaje. Pero hoy habla con sencillez a los Apóstoles y les da una imagen gráfica muy fácil de captar. Piensa en cuántas fotos has visto con una mano abierta sosteniendo semillas de mostaza, o la imagen de las semillas y el árbol crecido. El caso es que esas fotos valen más que mil palabras. Podríamos llamarlo el “discurso del ascensor” sobre la fe. Jesús proporciona a sus seguidores una piedra de toque a la que aferrarse, una hoja de ruta espiritual, por así decirlo. Pero junto a esa querida parábola hay un mensaje más difícil.

RECUERDA QUIÉN ERES

En algún momento, Jesús debe exasperarse con esta gente. ¿Los Apóstoles y los discípulos han estado siguiéndolo desde hace cuánto tiempo? Y todavía no lo entienden. El reino de Dios no se trata de cuán grande eres en la tierra, o cuánta fe tienes. Hay mucho trabajo por hacer. Él les recuerda que todavía son las personas que van a cocinar la cena cuando lleguen a casa por la noche. Ellos son los sirvientes. Su trabajo continúa hasta que la cocina esté limpia. Del mismo modo, no basta con que nos presentemos en la iglesia el domingo por la mañana. Debemos ser siervos en nuestra vida diaria. En la pantalla de mi ordenador hay una nota adhesiva amarilla que dice “Si servir está por debajo de ti, entonces el liderazgo está por encima de ti”. Ahora mismo, el “Liderazgo de Servicio” es una gran frase de moda que roza el uso excesivo, pero hay mucha verdad en ella. Algunas de las formas en las que podemos liderar nuestras familias, nuestros grupos de trabajo, nuestros grupos de fe incluyen: escuchar a los demás, mostrar empatía, curarse a sí mismo a través del equilibrio entre el trabajo y la vida, desarrollar su autoconciencia, y ser un buen administrador. Enfócalo como quieras, se trata de ser un buen cristiano. Tener fe. Sirve a los demás. Mira cómo crece.

2022 REFLEXIÓN RESPETEMOS LA VIDA

Llamados a servir a las madres necesitadas

Nuestra Santísima Madre es modelo de profundo testimonio de amor y vida en el relato del Evangelio de la Visitación.

El Evangelio según san Lucas nos dice que, cuando María se entera de que su prima Isabel está embarazada, va a una ciudad ubicada en los cerros “sin demora” (*Lc 1,39*). A pesar de estar embarazada de manera inesperada, María responde a esta noticia en forma urgente.

María emprende un viaje largo y tal vez difícil para estar con su prima durante su tiempo de necesidad, llevándole a Cristo mientras Él permanecía escondido silenciosamente en su seno. Y, aunque no sea posible ver a Jesús, apenas llega María, Juan Bautista salta de gozo en el vientre de Isabel, reconociendo la presencia de Cristo (*Lc 1,44*). María, con Jesús, pasa los tres meses siguientes al lado de Isabel.

El testimonio de nuestra Santísima Madre nos invita a ser más conscientes de las necesidades de las embarazadas y madres que crían hijos en nuestras propias parroquias y comunidades. Una mujer con un embarazo imprevisto puede tener muchos temores y dificultades: hacer frente a ser juzgada por sus amigos y familiares, perder su empleo o vivienda, o que el padre de su hijo la abandone.

*Mi alma canta la
grandeza del Señor,
y mi espíritu se
estremece de gozo
en Dios, mi salvador.
(Lucas 1,46-47).*

Siguiendo el ejemplo de María, nos podemos preguntar cómo conocer mejor a estas madres, escucharlas, buscar entenderlas y ayudarlas a satisfacer las necesidades de la vida para ellas y sus hijos. ¿De qué manera podemos, al igual que la Santísima Madre, apoyar amorosamente a las madres para que acojan y cuiden el don de Dios de la vida?


En toda la Sagrada Escritura, las palabras de María son pocas, pero en su encuentro sagrado con Isabel, de su boca sale una poderosa declaración. María proclama a todas las generaciones que el Señor *elevó a los humildes, colmó de bienes a los hambrientos, acordándose de su misericordia para siempre* (*Lc 1,46-56*). Con palabras y hechos, María da un mensaje de *esperanza*, no solo a Isabel, sino también a cada madre necesitada y a cada uno de nosotros.

Al hacerlo, también podemos llevar a Cristo dentro de nosotros y ayudar a otros a sentir Su presencia.**



Called to Serve Moms in Need



Our Blessed Mother models a profound witness to love and life in the Gospel account of the Visitation. Luke's Gospel tells us that, when Mary learns that her cousin Elizabeth is pregnant, she travels to the hill country "*in haste*" (Lk 1:39). Despite being unexpectedly pregnant herself, Mary responds to this news with urgency.

She embarks on a long and perhaps difficult journey to be with her cousin during her time of need, bearing Christ to her as He lay quietly hidden in Mary's womb. And, although Jesus is veiled from view, when Mary first arrives John the Baptist leaps for joy in Elizabeth's womb, recognizing the presence of Christ (Lk 1:44). Mary, with Jesus, spends the next three months at Elizabeth's side.

The witness of our Blessed Mother invites us to become more aware of the needs of pregnant and parenting moms in our own parishes and communities. A woman with an unexpected pregnancy may have any number of fears and challenges: facing judgment from her friends and family, losing her job or housing, or being abandoned by the father of her child.

Following Mary's example, we can ask ourselves how to better know these mothers, listen to them, seek understanding, and help them obtain the necessities of life for themselves and their children.¹ How can we, like the Blessed Mother, lovingly support mothers in welcoming and caring for God's gift of life?

Throughout the whole of Scripture, Mary's words are few. Yet, in her sacred encounter with Elizabeth, a powerful declaration pours from her lips. Mary proclaims to all generations that the Lord *lifts up the lowly, fills the hungry with good things, and remembers his promise of mercy from age to age* (Lk 1:46-56). In both word and deed, Mary speaks a

message of *hope*—not only to Elizabeth, but also to every mother in need and to each of us.

Mary's witness is an invitation to step out in love and compassion. It is a summons to *make haste* to help vulnerable women who may be isolated and alone. By doing so, we too can bear Christ within us and help others experience His presence.

Inspired by the Blessed Mother's example and guided by the Holy Spirit, may we offer Christ's presence and love to mothers in their time of need through our faithful service and support.
