Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

We are about to move into the season of Lent---may this truly be a time of grace and conversion within the RA-OLA Parish community! As usual, we begin together on Ash Wednesday; so I ask you to take time to reflect on how you can make more room for God in your life this Lent---through prayer, fasting, and charity towards others. Once again we are distributing "**Lenten Little Black Books**" (in English and Spanish) to encourage some prayerful meditation each day of Lent. All are invited to take part in the **Lenten Series with the Sisters: Open our Hearts**, on Mondays at RA and on Wednesdays at OLA. We are offering **Stations of the Cross** each week in both English and Spanish at both churches. For a more complete listing of prayer opportunities, see the Lenten Schedule in this bulletin.

This week's Gospel is one of the most challenging. Jesus says "offer no resistance to one who is evil." This is one of the "hard sayings of Jesus" because it seems so hard to put into practice. It seems opposed to our natural tendency to self-defense. If someone hurts us, we want to hurt them back, to retaliate. Jesus asks much more of his disciples than did the old law of retaliation ("an eye for an eye...")—he is expecting greater maturity of us, greater moral progress. This is the gospel of non-violent resistance to evil, at the heart of Jesus' message. Jesus implies that the passive resistance to evil, non-retaliation, will leave our enemy dumbfounded, confused. It can be a great source of moral persuasion and conversion. Some have taken this seriously (like Martin Luther King, Jr.) and made a great difference in the lives of others. May we let this Gospel challenge us to follow Jesus more closely, and to let his teaching rule our hearts!

Queridos amigos,



Estamos a punto de empezar la temporada de Cuaresma --- ¡Espero que este sea verdaderamente un tiempo de gracia y de conversión dentro de la comunidad parroquial de RA-OLA! Como de costumbre, comenzamos juntos el Miércoles de Ceniza; así que les pido que se tomen un momento para reflexionar cómo pueden hacer lugar para Dios en su vida durante esta Cuaresma, por medio de la oración, el ayuno y la caridad hacia los demás. Una vez más estamos distribuyendo los "Libritos Negros de Cuaresma" (en inglés y español) para motivarlos a hacer meditación orante cada día de Cuaresma. Todos están invitados a participar en las Series de Cuaresma en inglés con las Hermanas: Abre nuestros Corazones, los lunes en RA y los miércoles en OLA. Estamos ofreciendo el Vía Crucis cada semana en inglés y en español en ambas iglesias. Para obtener una lista más completa de las oportunidades de oración, consulte el Horario de Cuaresma en este boletín.

El Evangelio de esta semana es uno de los más desafiantes. Jesús nos dice "no hagan resistencia al hombre malo". Este es uno de las "enseñanzas más duras de Jesús" porque parece muy difícil ponerla en práctica. Parece opuesto a nuestra tendencia natural a la autodefensa. Si alguien nos lastima o hiere, queremos devolverles la ofensa o tomar represalias. Jesús pide mucho más de sus discípulos, nos pide que no sigamos la antigua ley del talión ("ojos por ojos..."): El espera una mayor madurez de nosotros, un mayor crecimiento moral. Este es el evangelio de la resistencia no violenta al mal, enseñanza que está en el corazón del mensaje de Jesús. Jesús nos da a entender que la resistencia pasiva al mal, sin represalias ni venganzas, dejará a nuestro enemigo estupefacto, confundido. Puede ser una gran fuente de persuasión moral y conversión. Algunos han puesto esto en práctica (como Martin Luther King, Jr. o Cesar Chavez) y han hecho una gran diferencia en la vida de los demás. ¡Pidamos para que este Evangelio nos desafíe a seguir a Jesús más de cerca y a dejar que sus enseñanzas gobiernen nuestros corazones!

Kindergarten and their 8th grade buddies drew a picture of themselves and wrote about what they did on Pajama Day. They danced together and read a story together.


First grade and their 6th grade buddies made a Valentine's Day heart with sentences written inside.



Regulations for Lent: All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain entirely from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and all Fridays during Lent. All Catholics between the ages of 18 - 59 inclusive are also bound to observe the law of fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (only one full meal).
