Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

Do we meet Jesus on the road, like the early disciples on their way to Emmaus?

This account from Luke's Gospel tells of one of the Resurrection appearances of Jesus—and what really surprises most of us is that these two disciples “did not recognize him.” How could that be—he was walking with them, on the road? Even if his appearance had changed after the Resurrection, how could they not have known it was Jesus? Maybe something got in the way. Was it their grief, at the loss of their leader and friend; was it the tragedy and shame of the cross; was it their anger at those who clamored for his crucifixion; was it their embarrassment that they had abandoned him in that most difficult hour? Still, in the end, they found in this stranger on the road, their Lord and Savior!

We need to realize that every day we have the opportunity to meet Jesus on the road. Too often, things get in the way for us. It may be our anger, our grief, our focus on ourselves or other challenges in our life that claim our attention and prevent us from seeing Jesus. But he promised his presence among us until the end of time. If we listen attentively to his word in the Scriptures, if we gather faithfully for the “breaking of the bread” and if we take time to reflect on our daily lives in faith, we can be sure that we will encounter the Risen one. We can be sure that we will recognize him in our own hearts, in our neighbor. We can be confident that he will set our hearts on fire with a new hope!

Queridos amigos,

¿Encontramos a Jesús en nuestro recorrer, al igual que aquellos discípulos que iban camino a Emaús?

Este relato del Evangelio de San Lucas habla de una de las apariciones de Jesús después de su resurrección, y lo que realmente sorprende a la mayoría de nosotros es que estos dos discípulos “no lo reconocieron”. ¿Cómo pudo pasar eso, él estaba caminando junto a ellos? Incluso si su apariencia hubiera cambiado después de la Resurrección, ¿cómo es que no se dieron cuenta que era Jesús? Tal vez algo les estaba obstaculizando. ¿Sería su dolor, por la pérdida de su líder y amigo; tal vez fue la tragedia y la vergüenza de la cruz; ¿O sería su enojo contra los que clamaron por su crucifixión? ¿O su propia vergüenza por haberlo abandonado en su hora más difícil? Sea lo que fuere, al final se les abrieron los ojos y encontraron en aquel extraño caminante, a su Señor y Salvador Resucitado!

Nosotros también necesitamos darnos cuenta de que todos los días tenemos la oportunidad de encontrarnos con Jesús en nuestro propio caminar. Con demasiada frecuencia, hay cosas que se interponen y nos impiden reconocerlo. Puede ser nuestro enojo, nuestro dolor por haber perdido a un ser querido, nuestro egoísmo al enfocarnos solo en nosotros mismos, o tal vez otros desafíos en nuestra propia vida que reclaman nuestra atención y nos impiden ver a Jesús. Pero Él nos prometió estar presente entre nosotros hasta el fin de los tiempos. Si escuchamos atentamente su Palabra en las Escrituras, si nos reunimos fielmente para la “fracción del pan” y si dedicamos tiempo para reflexionar en nuestra fe y ponerla en práctica en nuestra vida cotidiana, podemos estar seguros de que encontraremos al Resucitado. Podemos estar seguros de que lo reconoceremos en nuestros propios corazones, en nuestro prójimo. ¡Podemos estar seguros de que Él hará nuestros corazones arder con su amor y nos dará una nueva esperanza!



Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

For us, the baptized, the road to Emmaus is repeated every Sunday when we participate in the Eucharist. Christ comes out to meet us and give encouragement and hope to our hearts. Those two pilgrims were disappointed along the way, while fleeing from Jerusalem. But, on the way home, they met Jesus without recognizing him. That is what is interesting, that that man seemed unaware of the reality of Good Friday, of that scandalous death on the cross. To the surprise of the pilgrims, the man seemed to have plenty of knowledge in Scripture and faith. Their eyes were opened when he broke the bread and that is when they recognized Jesus. The profound dialogue with that traveler and their dinner with him made them return on fire, to the community they had already decided to leave: "Weren't our hearts burning within us when he talked to us on the road and explained the Scriptures to us?" (Luke 24,32). Stay with us, Lord, we need you as a companion on our journey. Come out to meet us in the family and society. Do you know someone sad and hopeless, sick or abandoned? Approach this person and offer them your love and affection, share the bread and the wisdom that this Gospel of Emmaus offers us. The challenge and invitation this Easter is to be a committed Christian who brightens the path of those around you. We are also invited to meditate on Sacred Scripture as a family.
