Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

Between the confusion mentioned in the Gospel and the complaints of favoritism and neglect mentioned in the reading from Acts, it is clear that the human factor in the Church has always been present. You might even say it's comforting to know that the early Church had its challenges too! It had issues to face, and, with courage and creativity it was able to face them. That is what it took to respond to the neglect experienced by the Greek-speaking widows in the early community. More recently, it was announced last week that in this fall's "Synod of Bishops" meeting in Rome, women and lay men will be included as voting members at the Synod for the first time. Perhaps this is Pope Francis' way of responding to some of those who feel their voice has been neglected in the life of the Church today. It seems to be an important change in the voting rules, to allow the Bishops to hear more clearly from the laity of the Church.

In addition, the Scriptures this weekend tell us plainly: "Do not let your hearts be troubled"—those are words that we the Church need to hear in every age. God plays an active part in our lives, if we open our hearts to his message, if we listen. We trust that the Spirit will guide us, so that the Church might go forward in faith and renewal now as it did in its beginnings.


Finally, we pray for our parish children receiving their First Holy Communion, both this weekend and next. May they always know God's love in their lives, and frequently receive his gifts, especially the Eucharist!

Entre la confusión mencionada en el Evangelio y las quejas de favoritismo y falta de cuidado mencionadas en los Hechos de los Apóstoles, está claro que las debilidades humanas siempre han estado presentes en la iglesia. ¡Incluso podríamos decir que es reconfortante saber que la iglesia primitiva también tuvo sus dificultades! Tuvieron problemas que enfrentar, pero con valor y creatividad, pudieron enfrentarlos. Así fue como respondieron al desprecio experimentado por las viudas griegas en aquella comunidad de iglesia primitiva. Más recientemente, se anunció la semana pasada que en la reunión del "Sínodo de los Obispos" de este otoño en Roma, mujeres y hombres laicos serán incluidos como miembros con derecho a voto en el Sínodo por primera vez. Quizás esta sea la forma en que el Papa Francisco responde a algunos de los que sienten que su voz no ha sido escuchada en la vida de la iglesia hasta el día de hoy. Parece ser un cambio importante en las reglas de votación, para permitir que los obispos escuchen más claramente a los laicos de la iglesia.

Además, las Escrituras de este fin de semana nos dicen claramente: "Que no se turbe su corazón", esas son palabras que nosotros, miembros de la Iglesia, necesitamos escuchar en cada época, en cada generación. Dios juega un papel activo en nuestra vida, si abrimos nuestros corazones a su mensaje, si le escuchamos. Confiamos en que el Espíritu Santo nos guiará, para que la iglesia continúe avanzando en la fe y en la renovación.

Finalmente, pedimos a Dios por los niños de nuestra parroquia que recibirán su Primera Comunión, tanto este fin de semana como el próximo. ¡Que ellos siempre experimenten el amor de Dios en sus vidas y que reciban con frecuencia sus dones, especialmente la Eucaristía!





"La muerte de un jornalero", de Robert Frost, es un poema sobre Silas, un viejo jornalero vagabundo, y Warren y Mary, una pareja de granjeros que dan una habitación

a Silas siempre que viene. Silas viene cuando menos se le necesita y se marcha cuando su presencia sería más útil, todo lo cual frustra a Warren. En el poema, Silas ha vuelto y Mary cree que será la última vez, que se está muriendo. Le dice a Warren que el suyo es el único hogar que tiene Silas. Warren se limita a sacudir la cabeza, como si se burlara suavemente de la idea de hogar: "El hogar es el lugar donde, cuando tienes que ir, / te tienen que acoger". María lo dice de otro modo: "Debería haberlo llamado / Algo que de algún modo no has de merecer".

¿No es ésa también la promesa de Jesús? "En la casa de mi Padre hay muchas moradas. Si no las hubiera, ¿os habría dicho que voy a prepararos un lugar?". (Juan 14:2). Algo que de alguna manera no hemos de merecer. ●

Some would say that the purpose of life is to save one's soul. And certainly we should try, with the grace of God, to live our lives in such a way that we avoid evil and do good in order to do our part in building God's kingdom on earth. At the same time, we must remember that it is God who saves us. We don't save ourselves. Eternal life and happiness are byproducts of loving others. If the focus of one's life is to be happy, one never achieves it. If one seeks to serve others, however, happiness seems to find us. So also eternal life.

Robert Frost's "The Death of a Hired Man" is a poem about Silas, an aging drifter farmhand, and Warren and Mary, a farming couple who give Silas a room whenever he comes around.

Silas comes when he is needed the least and leaves when his presence would be most helpful, all of which frustrates Warren. In the poem Silas has returned, and Mary thinks it will be his last time, that he is dying. She says to Warren that theirs is the only home Silas has. Warren simply shakes his head as if to gently mock the idea of home: "Home is the place where, when you have to go there, / They have to take you in." Mary says it differently, "I should have called it / Something you somehow haven't to deserve."

Is that not also the promise of Jesus? "In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?" (John 14:2). Something we somehow haven't to deserve. ●
