Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

For over fifty years, we have had a “Charismatic Movement” in the Catholic Church. It arose out of the Pentecostal movement in Protestant circles, and has strong biblical roots. One of the ideas popular in the movement is “Baptism in the Spirit.” For some, this is interpreted as a necessary ingredient in one’s deeper conversion to Christ. However, to some degree all who are baptized are baptized in the Spirit, for we believe the Spirit is given to us at Baptism (and Confirmation). The Charismatic experience of “baptism in the Spirit” highlights the fact that many adults need to gather in prayer, in community, to experience more deeply the great effects of the Spirit’s presence within them, and to activate those gifts.

In today's Scriptures, Jesus speaks to his disciples of the Advocate which he promises to send, to be with us always. This is the Holy Spirit promised to each of us by Jesus, reassuring us of his presence with us. We cannot see the Risen Christ in visible form, as his disciples did in the days after the Resurrection---but the Church is promised his presence. The age of the Church is the age of the Spirit. The Spirit guides our decisions if we remember to call upon God's inspiration. We pray that the Spirit's love will guide us; we pray that the bread of the Eucharist will fill us—for only in Christ is our hunger and thirst truly satisfied! May we always be conscious of his presence within and among us.

Please pray for the young people of our parish who will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation in these next two weeks—that God's Spirit may strengthen them in faith and his fruits be seen in their good works!

This weekend, we also pray in a special way for God's blessings on all the Mothers of the parish as we celebrate Mother's day. May God bless you always!

Estaré siempre con ustedes

Por más de cincuenta años, hemos tenido el “Movimiento Carismático” en la Iglesia Católica. Este movimiento surgió del movimiento pentecostal en los círculos evangélicos-protestantes y tiene fuertes raíces bíblicas. Una de las ideas populares en el movimiento carismático es el “Bautismo en el Espíritu”. Para algunos, esto se interpreta como un ingrediente necesario para una conversión más profunda en Cristo Jesús. Sin embargo, hasta cierto punto, todos los que hemos sido bautizados somos bautizados en el Espíritu, porque nuestra Fe nos enseña que el Espíritu Santo se nos da en el Bautismo (y también en la Confirmación). La experiencia carismática del “bautismo en el Espíritu” destaca el hecho de que muchos adultos necesitan reunirse en oración, renovarse en comunidad, para experimentar más profundamente los grandes efectos de la presencia del Espíritu Santo en ellos y activar sus dones.

En las Escrituras de hoy, Jesús habla a sus discípulos del Paráclito que promete enviar, para que esté siempre con nosotros, el Espíritu de la verdad. Este es el Espíritu Santo prometido a cada uno de nosotros por Jesús, asegurándonos de que su presencia estará siempre entre nosotros. No podemos ver a Cristo Resucitado en forma visible, como lo vieron sus discípulos en los días posteriores a la Resurrección, pero a la Iglesia se le promete su presencia constante. La era de la Iglesia empieza con la venida del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. El Espíritu guía nuestras decisiones, si nosotros recordamos invocar la inspiración de Dios. Pidamos para que el amor del Espíritu nos guíe; pidamos para que el Pan Vivo de la Eucaristía nos llene, ¡porque solo en Cristo nuestra hambre y nuestra sed serán verdaderamente saciadas! Ojalá que siempre estemos conscientes de su presencia dentro de nosotros y a nuestro alrededor.



There are moments when we realize the baton has been passed to us, and now we must conduct the symphony of our lives. One such moment may be when both parents have died. “They” say we never fully grow up until that occurs, for from that time on we can no longer go home. I know of a daughter who received a gift from her mother when the daughter moved out on her own. Inside, the daughter discovered a pair of apron strings, a symbol of her break with home. At various times, life hands us a bountiful serving of responsibility as we commit to a vocation, or for many, become parents for the first time. On such occasions, the future may weigh heavily upon us.

This week’s Gospel is a farewell speech of sorts. Given to the Twelve on the night before his passion and death, Jesus promises he will not leave us orphans and that the Spirit will be given to us to do what we must do.

There have been any number of times when life has unfolded for me into new circumstances and life roles, occasions often filled with anxiety and sometimes even fear. I usually found I could deal with such realities by asking myself what would be the worst that could happen, and if it did, could I handle it? Every time, I found myself realizing I *could* handle the worst. Importantly, the ability to do what needs doing always seems to flow from God’s Spirit that is given to each of us. If our faith in God is alive in us, our spiritual apron strings are never severed. ●

Hay momentos en los que nos damos cuenta de que nos han pasado la batuta, y ahora debemos dirigir la sinfonía de nuestras vidas. Uno de esos momentos puede ser cuando han muerto ambos padres. “Dicen que nunca crecemos del todo hasta que eso ocurre, porque a partir de ese momento ya no podemos volver a casa. Sé de una hija que recibió un regalo de su madre cuando la hija se fue a vivir sola. Dentro, la hija descubrió un par de cordones de delantal, símbolo de su ruptura con el hogar. En diversos momentos, la vida nos ofrece una abundante ración de responsabilidad cuando nos comprometemos con una vocación o, para muchos, nos convertimos en padres por primera vez. En tales ocasiones, el futuro puede pesar mucho sobre nosotros.

El Evangelio de esta semana es una especie de discurso de despedida. Pronunciado ante los Doce la noche anterior a su pasión y muerte, Jesús promete que no nos dejará huérfanos y que se nos dará el Espíritu para hacer lo que debamos hacer.

Ha habido muchas ocasiones en las que la vida me ha deparado nuevas circunstancias y papeles vitales, ocasiones a menudo llenas de ansiedad y a veces incluso de miedo. Por lo general, descubrí que podía afrontar estas realidades preguntándome qué sería lo peor que podría ocurrir y, si ocurriera, ¿podría afrontarlo? Siempre me daba cuenta de que podía afrontar lo peor. Y lo que es más importante, la capacidad de hacer lo que hay que hacer parece fluir siempre del Espíritu de Dios que se nos da a cada uno de nosotros. Si nuestra fe en Dios está viva en nosotros, las cuerdas de nuestro delantal espiritual nunca se cortan. ●
