**Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco**

Dear Friends,

"The apostles....went to the upper room where they were staying....All these devoted themselves with one accord to prayer." [Acts 1:12-13] Today's liturgy places us in the time between the Ascension and Pentecost, along with Mary, the Apostles and other disciples of Jesus. We can imagine that it was a time of uncertainty for the disciples—although they had experienced the Resurrection and Ascension of Jesus, they did not know what was coming next.

Let me ask you: Can we enter into that same spirit of prayer, persevere with one accord, without divisions or conflicts, as we approach the feast of Pentecost? How does the gracious gift of God's grace in Jesus challenge us to transform our lives, to transform our world, as we work out our mission as Church? How can we work for peace, in our hearts, in our community, in our world? How can we serve those in need? How can we share the Gospel with our brothers and sisters who feel distanced or excluded from the Church? How can we reach out to the alienated, to the young? How can we be instruments of healing for those who are hurting? How can we find time for prayer in our daily lives? I invite you to reflect on these seven questions throughout this coming week as we approach the feast of Pentecost. I invite you to keep these intentions in prayer for ourselves, for our parish and for our Church.

Finally, I want to mention that **next Saturday evening, May 27th, we will be holding an extended, overnight vigil of prayer for the feast of Pentecost, at Our Lady of the Angelus Church.** Please see the bulletin for details. All are welcome! Spirit of God, come dwell in our hearts!

Les invito a reflexionar sobre estas siete preguntas a lo largo de esta semana venidera, a medida que nos acercamos a la festividad de Pentecostés; los invito a mantener estas intenciones en oración por nosotros mismos, por nuestra parroquia y por nuestra Iglesia.



## Power Unmasked

**W**hen the Lone Ranger and Tonto rode across our TV screens in days of old, someone would often ask, “Who was that masked man?” Folks never learned his identity, and it didn’t matter. For that man had saved them from evil, restoring their lives. In a sense, the Ranger, with Tonto, had passed on to them the power to live safely and productively.

As he was about to return to his Father, the risen Lord said to the apostles, “You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses” (Acts 1:8). Yet being blessed with the power that raised the Lord Jesus does not always feel much like a blessing. At times it can feel more like a burden that falls upon our shoulders, one to heal and mend as we try to bring peace and a better world. We wonder why we always must be the one who says, “I’m sorry.” Why must we always be the one who plans the evening out or writes the Christmas cards or calls Mom or spends time with the children or listens to someone’s tale of woe? Yet such is the power of Jesus for bringing about healing to both spirits and bodies, for creating joy, for designing bridges into the hearts of others, all because the Messiah rode off on a cloud of silver to be welcomed to the right hand of God. Thus, he empowers us. ●
