Dear Friends,

As we come together in church this weekend, we hear how Jesus summons the twelve to proclaim the message of the kingdom—his fundamental message which was meant to change hearts and minds and open us to God's ways! To get the message out, Jesus calls the twelve—by name. He sends them to proclaim a message of hope and healing to a people who desperately need to hear it!

Where can we find our place in this Gospel? Finally, we wish a Happy Father's Day to all the fathers and grandfathers in our parish. May their witness of love and sacrifice also be a witness to the love of Jesus at the heart of our families.



Bucket List Questions

The Bucket List is a movie about two men, played by Jack Nicholson and Morgan Freeman, who find themselves sharing a hospital room, each diagnosed with terminal cancer. As they talk about the days that remain for each of them, they begin to discuss what they would yet hope to experience before they die. Hence, the title of the film.

At one point amid their many escapades together, Freeman suggests that God is going to ask two questions when they stand before the pearly gates. Nicholson hears this and grows edgy, suspecting his eternal future may be at risk. Freeman then tells him that the first question will be, “Have you ever experienced joy in life?” At that, Nicholson beams with a silly grin that suggests he is thinking more of pleasure than he is of joy. Nonetheless, he decides his lock on eternal bliss is halfway there. Then Freeman reveals the second question: “Have you ever brought joy to the lives of others?” With that, Nicholson’s face drops, realizing his life has been more about himself than about others.

Religion is not just about “going to church” but also about “going from church into the world.” That, in a sense, is what Jesus did when he named the twelve apostles and sent them out to heal, bring life, and overcome evil. It is also what we find ourselves sent to do amid the scattered events of every week—to bring joy into the lives of others. ●

Preguntas sobre Bucket List

The Bucket List es una película sobre dos hombres, interpretados por Jack Nicholson y Morgan Freeman, que se encuentran compartiendo habitación en un hospital, diagnosticados cada uno de un cáncer terminal. Mientras hablan de los días que les quedan a cada uno, empiezan a discutir sobre lo que aún desearían experimentar antes de morir. De ahí el título de la película.


En un momento dado, en medio de sus muchas escapadas juntos, Freeman sugiere que Dios les va a hacer dos preguntas cuando estén ante las puertas del cielo. Nicholson lo oye y se pone nervioso, sospechando que su futuro eterno puede estar en peligro. Freeman le dice entonces que la primera pregunta será: “¿Has experimentado alguna vez la alegría en la vida?”. Ante eso, Nicholson sonríe con una sonrisa tonta que sugiere que está pensando más en el placer que en la alegría. No obstante, decide que su cerrojo sobre la dicha eterna está a medio camino. Entonces Freeman revela la segunda pregunta: “¿Has aportado alguna vez alegría a la vida de los demás?”. Y Nicholson se queda boquiabierto al darse cuenta de que su vida ha girado más en torno a sí mismo que a los demás.

La religión no consiste sólo en “ir a la iglesia”, sino también en “ir de la iglesia al mundo”. En cierto sentido, eso es lo que hizo Jesús cuando nombró a los doce apóstoles y los envió a curar, dar vida y vencer el mal. También es lo que nos vemos enviados a hacer en medio de los acontecimientos dispersos de cada semana: llevar alegría a la vida de los demás. ●
