## ***Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco***

Dear Friends,

We hear these encouraging words in today's Gospel: "Are not two sparrows sold for a small coin? Yet not one of them falls to the ground without your Father's knowledge. Even all the hairs of your head are counted. So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows." We can have many fears: we can fear the loss of people, of health, of our possessions. Some fears are hard to avoid. A cancer diagnosis comes, for yourself or a loved one, and all sorts of questions are raised. What is the best course of treatment, in which hospital or doctor should we place our trust? Whatever you choose, you can fear what the outcome may be. Or, the economy takes a downturn, and you start to worry about your steady income, or what may happen to your job, or that of another family member.

Jesus' ultimate message is one of reassurance. He simply means that God cares for us, and deeply. God knows us better than we know ourselves, down to the hairs on our head. Still, God cares for us, loves us, and promises to always be with us. Despite our sins and imperfections, our flaws and failings, that is Jesus' rock solid promise! If we can bring that awareness to our daily life, and bring it to those around us, we will be God's messengers of peace and healing in our fragile world.

We bid a fond farewell this week to Sister Virginia, Father Conlon, and Benoit—may they always be assured of God's loving presence in their lives, and may they know our gratitude for the many gifts they have shared with us!


## What Is a Soul, if Not...?

The Gospel of Matthew warns that the greater danger is not about those who may kill the body, but rather it is about those who can destroy both body and soul. Indeed, what if our soul dies long before our body dies? What then has become of our living?

Henry David Thoreau spent a year at Walden Pond in 1845. He did not go to escape life, he said, but to preserve it, to live it more fully. "I went to the woods because I wished to live deliberately, to front only the essential facts of life, and see if I could not learn what it had to teach, and not when I came to die, discover that I had not lived," he wrote in *Walden* in 1854. "I did not wish to live what was not life, living is so dear, nor did I wish to practice resignation, unless it was quite necessary. I wanted to live deep and suck out all the marrow of life, to live so sturdily and Spartan-like as to put to rout all that was not life."

To have a soul is not as if some other-worldly reality has been given a home in our body. Rather, to have a soul is to have a source of hope even in the face of failure, to love in imitation of Jesus even when we are not loved, to see goodness even when it is hidden, to trust in God even when we are powerless. It is the source of mystery, of all that is transcendent, the home of all that is holy. ●

## ¿Qué es un alma, si no...?

**E**l Evangelio de Mateo advierte de que el mayor peligro no son los que pueden matar el cuerpo, sino los que pueden destruir tanto el cuerpo como el alma. En efecto, ¿qué ocurre si nuestra alma muere mucho antes que nuestro cuerpo? ¿Qué ha sido entonces de nuestra vida?

Henry David Thoreau pasó un año en Walden Pond en 1845. No fue para escapar de la vida, dijo, sino para preservarla, para vivirla más plenamente. “Fui al bosque porque deseaba vivir deliberadamente, enfrentarme sólo a los hechos esenciales de la vida, y ver si no podía aprender lo que tenía que enseñarme, y no descubrir, cuando llegara la hora de morir, que no había vivido”, escribió en *Walden* en 1854. “No deseaba vivir lo que no era vida, vivir es tan caro, ni practicar la resignación, a menos que fuera del todo necesario. Quería vivir profundamente y succionar toda la médula de la vida, vivir tan robusta y espartanamente como para acabar con todo lo que no fuera vida.”

Tener alma no es como si una realidad de otro mundo se hubiera instalado en nuestro cuerpo. Más bien, tener alma es tener una fuente de esperanza incluso ante el fracaso, amar a imitación de Jesús incluso cuando no somos amados, ver la bondad incluso cuando está oculta, confiar en Dios incluso cuando somos impotentes. Es la fuente del misterio, de todo lo trascendente, el hogar de todo lo santo. ●



## A missionary priest from the Diocese of Bomadi in Nigeria will speak at all the masses at Our Lady of the Angelus church on July 1 & 2



The Catholic Diocese of Bomadi was carved out of Warri and Port Harcourt Dioceses in 2017. As of 2022, the Diocese of Bomadi has 46 parishes, 2 male religious congregations and 10 female religious congregations. In addition, the Diocese has 60 Diocesan Priests, 1 Minor Seminary, 2 health centers and 26 academic institutions.

The Diocese of Bomadi's territory is one-third located on land, and the rest on water, in one of the most remote areas of the Niger-Delta of Nigeria. They need financial assistance to support the vocations to the priesthood. Every year they receive applications from hundreds of young men who want to serve God as priests, but they can only accept about 5 candidates because of their lack of funds. They also need financial support in other areas of their mission.

## Un sacerdote misionero de la diócesis de Bomadi en Nigeria hablará en todas las misas en la iglesia de Nuestra Señora del Ángelus el 1 y 2 de julio.

La Diócesis Católica de Bomadi se separó de las Diócesis de Warri y Port Harcourt en 2017.

A partir de 2022, la Diócesis de Bomadi tiene 46 parroquias, 2 congregaciones religiosas masculinas y 10 congregaciones religiosas femeninas. Además, la Diócesis cuenta con 60 Sacerdotes Diocesanos, 1 Seminario Menor, 2 centros de salud y 26 instituciones académicas.

El territorio de la Diócesis de Bomadi es un tercio en tierra y el resto en agua, en una de las áreas más remotas del Delta del río Níger en Nigeria. Ellos necesitan asistencia financiera para apoyar las vocaciones al sacerdocio. Cada año reciben solicitudes de cientos de jóvenes que quieren servir a Dios como sacerdotes, pero solo pueden aceptar alrededor de 5 candidatos por falta de fondos. También necesitan apoyo financiero en otras áreas de su misión.
